

AMENDMENT NO. 1
PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT
CITY OF GLENDALE, Contract No. C19-0245

This Amendment No. 1 (“Amendment”) to the Professional Service Agreement (“Agreement”) is made this _____ day of _____, 20____, (“Effective Date”), by and between the City of Glendale, an Arizona municipal corporation (“City”) and Adams and Associates Engineers, P.L.L.C., an Arizona limited liability company, authorized to do business in Arizona (“Contractor”).

RECITALS

- A. City and Adams and Associates Engineers, P.L.L.C. (“Contractor”) previously entered into Professional Service Agreement, Contract No. C19-0245, dated March 27, 2019 (“Agreement”); and
- B. The original Professional Service Agreement Contract No. C19-0245, has an initial one year term effective March 27, 2019 through March 27, 2020 with the option to extend up to a maximum of four (4) additional years; and
- C. On March 27, 2020, City and Contractor previously entered into Contract Extension No. 1 extending the term of the agreement from March 27, 2020 through March 26, 2021; and
- D. On March 26, 2021, City and Contractor previously entered into Contract Extension No. 2 extending the term of the agreement from March 27, 2021 through March 26, 2022; and
- E.. City and Contractor wish to modify and amend the Agreement subject to and strictly in accordance with the terms of this Amendment.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the City and Contractor hereby agree as follows:

1. **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are not merely recitals, but form an integral part of this Amendment.
2. **Term.** The term of the Agreement is unchanged.
3. **Scope of Work.** The Scope of Work is unchanged.
4. **Compensation.** Section 4.1 of the Agreement is hereby modified and amended as follows:

4.1 Contractor's compensation amount is amended and increased from \$45,000 to \$100,000. Total compensation available to Contractor will not exceed \$100,000 for the entire term of the agreement (initial plus any extensions.)

5. **Insurance Certificate.** Current certificate will expire on October 07, 2021. A new certificate applying to the extended term must be provided prior to this date to Materials Management and the Contract Administrator.
6. **Non-discrimination.** Contractor must not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, genetic characteristics, familial status, U.S. military veteran status or any disability. Contractor will require any Sub-contractor to be bound to the same requirements as stated within this section. Contractor, and on behalf of any subcontractors, warrants compliance with this section.
7. **No Boycott of Israel.** To the extent A.R.S § 35-393 through § 35-393.03 are applicable, the parties hereby certify that they are not currently engaged in, and agree for the duration of the Agreement to not engage in, a boycott of goods or services from Israel, as that term is defined in A.R.S § 35-393.
8. **Attestation of PCI Compliance.** When applicable, the Contractor will provide the City annually with a Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS) attestation of compliance certificate signed by an officer of Contractor with oversight responsibility.
9. **Ratification of Agreement.** City and Contractor hereby agree that except as expressly provided herein, the provisions of the Agreement shall be, and remain in full force and effect and that if any provision of this Amendment conflicts with the Agreement, then the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.
