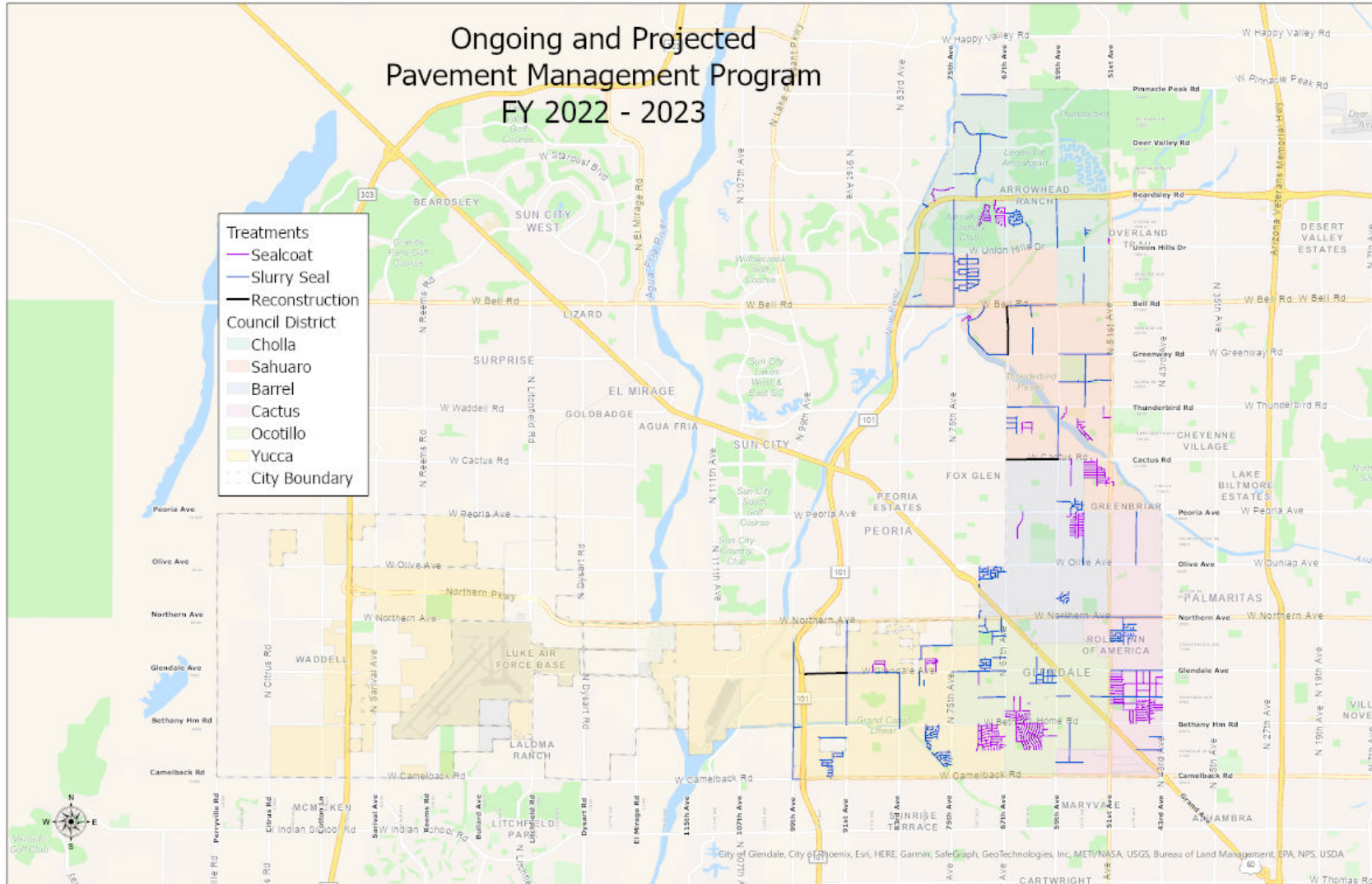


FY 2022 PMP Activity

 - Bethany Home Rd (75th Ave to 59th Ave), was in very bad shape and received a heavy slurry seal treatment



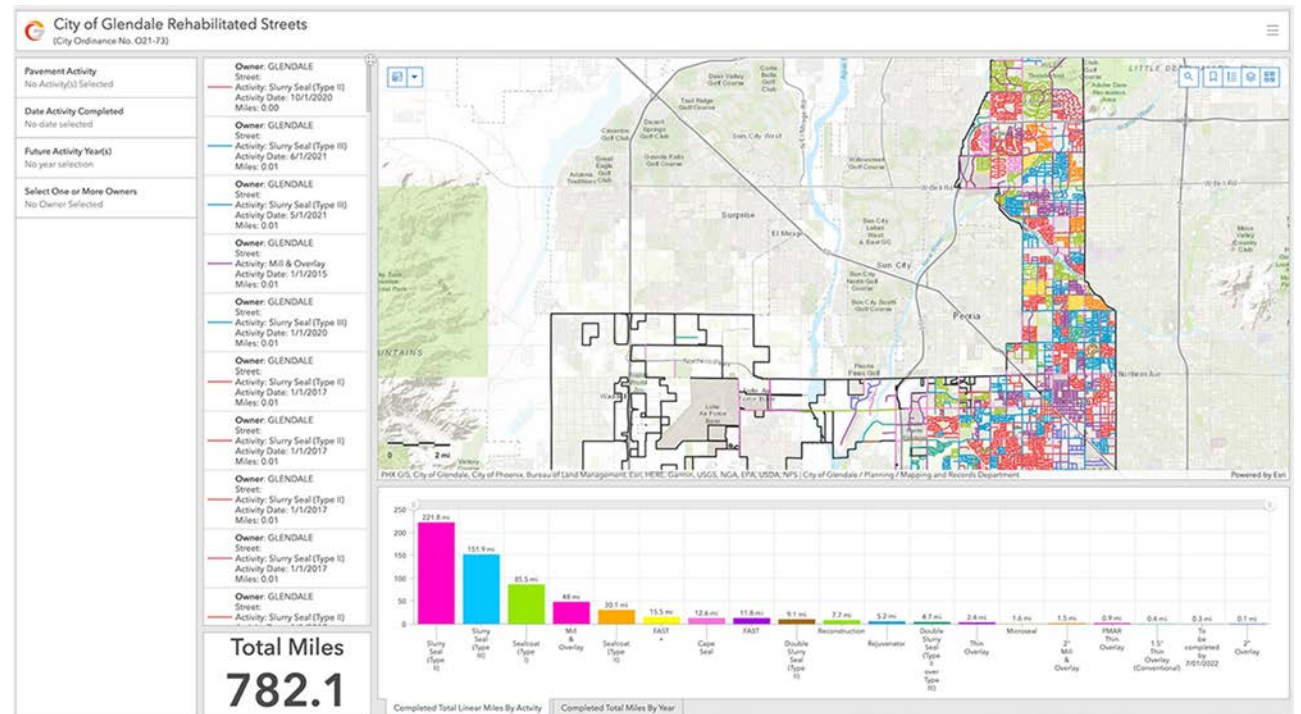

ARP Activity

- Glendale Ave (91st Ave – Loop 101)
 - Final Design Complete
 - Construction Start June 6
 - Anticipated Construction Completion September 2022
 - PCI 38 (2019)
 - AADT 25,500 (2018)
 - A very important economic corridor for the City!



ARP Activity

- Cactus Rd (59th Ave – 67th Ave)
 - Final design nearing completion
 - Anticipated construction start Sept/Oct 2022
- 67th Ave (Greenway Rd – Bell Rd)
 - Final design nearing completion
 - Anticipated construction start Jan 2023



FY 2023 Bridge Repair Activity

- New River Bridge @ Glendale Ave
 - Spall repairs on substructure
 - Joints repairs
 - Reset bearings
- Arizona Canal Bridge @ Cactus Rd
 - Replace joints
- Arizona Canal/Diversion Channel Bridge @ Cactus Rd
 - Repair concrete on superstructure
