

RESOLUTION NO. 8512

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A CONSULTANT AGREEMENT FOR CITYWIDE PARKING STUDY WITH KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES

WHEREAS, the City of Hawthorne has a high population density and many multi-generational households; and

WHEREAS, the demand for on-street parking in residential neighborhoods has placed significant pressure on the local street network; and

WHEREAS, parking near commercial centers is often inefficiently used, as spaces are dominated by employee vehicles, limiting availability for shoppers and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the City has implemented an ongoing strategies to address parking challenges, such as the installation of “Parking Ts” to optimize curb space usage, and implemented its Preferential Parking Program; and

WHEREAS, recent state policies such as Senate Bill 9 and Assembly Bill 2097, which reduce parking requirements for developments near transit corridors have further exacerbated the City’s parking issues; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hawthorne Department of Public Works reached out to its two on-call traffic engineering consultants to submit a proposal to perform a Citywide Parking Study to address the growing parking challenges; and

WHEREAS, the City selected Kimley-Horn and Associates as the consultant for the Citywide Parking Study from the list of consultants that replied to the City’s request for proposals.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE HEREBY FINDS, DETERMINES AND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Hawthorne, California hereby incorporates by reference above recitals and finds that they are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby approves the Consultant Agreement between Kimley-Horn and Associates and the City.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Consultant Agreement with Kimley-Horn and Associates and make any minor amendments thereto.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and shall cause this resolution and this certification to be entered in the Book of resolutions of the Council of the City of Hawthorne.

SECTION 5. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption thereof.
