

ORDINANCE NO. 1039

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE, CALIFORNIA,
ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE OF
THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE, CALIFORNIA,
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That present Sections 9-100, 9-101 and 9-102
of Article I of Chapter 9 of the Hawthorne Municipal Code are
hereby repealed in their entirety and in substitution thereof
the following are added:

"CHAPTER 9 - HEALTH AND SAFETY

SECTION 9-100 HEALTH CODE ESTABLISHED.

That in accordance with the procedure designated
in Sections 50001, et seq., of the Government Code of
the State of California, there is hereby adopted by
reference as the Health Code of the City of Hawthorne,
that certain set of health regulations known as the
"Public Health Code of the County of Los Angeles,"
as adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County
of Los Angeles on August 25, 1959, and also entitled
"Ordinance No. 7583", together with all amendments
thereof or supplementary thereto adopted to date.

"SECTION 9-101 FOOD ESTABLISHMENT. PERMIT REQUIRED.

No person shall conduct any business for the
purpose of selling, storing, manufacturing, preparing
or serving to the public any food or food stuffs in
the City without a permit issued by the Health Officer.
The Health Officer may withhold the issuance of a
permit to any person, until such person has complied
with all of the provisions of this Code. At such
time as the Health Officer is satisfied such person

has complied with the provisions of this Code, then such permit shall be issued.

"SECTION 9-102 FOOD ESTABLISHMENT TO INCLUDE PERMIT REQUIRED.


For the purposes of this Code, a person engaged in the business of a rooming house, boarding house or lodging house, who serves food, beverages or meals to his roomers, boarders or lodgers, shall be deemed to be a food establishment and no person shall conduct the business of rooming house, boarding house or lodging house at which food, beverages or meals are served to the customers, without a permit issued by the Health Officer. The Health Officer may withhold the issuance of a permit to any person, until such person has complied with all of the provisions of this Code. At such time as the Health Officer is satisfied such person has complied with the provisions of this Code, then such permit shall be issued."

SECTION 2. Any violations of said County Code, hereby adopted as the Health Code of the City of Hawthorne, shall be punishable as a misdemeanor under the provisions of Section 1-104 of the Hawthorne Municipal Code.


SECTION 3. It is the intent of the City Council hereby to repeal or amend all provisions of the Hawthorne Municipal Code contrary or conflicting with the provisions of the Public Health Code of the County of Los Angeles, specifically repealing Sections 9-103, 9-104, 9-105 of Article 1, each and every section of Article 5 excepting therefrom Section 9-502, every section of Article 6 excepting therefrom Section 9-602, and each and every section of Article 7 excepting therefrom Sections 9-701 and 702 of said Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall go into effect and become operative thirty (30) days from the date of approval, adoption and passage. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Hawthorne, California.
