

RESOLUTION NO. 8514

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A AGREEMENT FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION DESIGN AND INSTALLATION PROJECT WITH CHARGIE

WHEREAS, the City of Hawthorne has a high population density and many multi-generational households; and

WHEREAS, the demand for public accessible EV Charging Stations in residential neighborhoods has increased and placed pressure on the City to provide the infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, existing EV Chargers in the City are located on Commercial properties and spaces are limited and often taken by shoppers and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the City has implemented an ongoing strategy to address the limited amount of infrastructure for EV Chargers, such as the installation of “EV Chargers” at local public City facilities such as Jim Thorpe Park, Holly Glenn Park, Holly Park, Hawthorne Memorial park/Senior Center and Hawthorne Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hawthorne Department of Public Works solicited proposals for the design and installation of EV Chargers at multiple city facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City selected Chargeie as the service provider for the design and installation of EV Chargers at multiple city facilities from the list of consultants that replied to the City’s request for proposals.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE HEREBY FINDS, DETERMINES AND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Hawthorne, California hereby incorporates by reference above recitals and finds that they are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby approves the Agreement between Chargeie and the City.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized, to execute the Agreement with Chargeie and make any minor amendments thereto.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and shall cause this resolution and this certification to be entered in the Book of resolutions of the Council of the City of Hawthorne.

SECTION 5. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption thereof.
