

RESOLUTION NO. 8567

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A CONSULTANT AGREEMENT FOR ON-STREET PAID PARKING, PARKING ENFORCEMENT AND REVENUE COLLECTION WITH LAZ PARKING CA, LLC

WHEREAS, the City of Hawthorne has a high population density and many multi-generational households; and

WHEREAS parking near commercial centers is often inefficiently used, as spaces are dominated by employee vehicles, limiting availability for shoppers and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hawthorne Department of Public Works has been coordinating with Kimley-Horn and Associates, its consultant for the Citywide Parking Study, to address the growing parking challenges; and

WHEREAS, the City requires professional services to assist with the implementation, enforcement, management, and revenue collection associated with the paid parking program; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to implement a pilot on-street paid parking program to improve parking turnover, support local businesses, enhance neighborhood access, and manage curb space more effectively; and

WHEREAS, the City issued Request for Proposals (RFP) for qualified firms to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, after evaluating proposals and conducting interviews, City staff recommends entering into a Consultant Services Agreement with LAZ Parking CA, LLC to provide professional services for on-street paid parking implementation, parking enforcement, citation processing, meter operations, revenue collection, customer service support, and related program management.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE HEREBY FINDS, DETERMINES AND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Hawthorne, California hereby incorporates by reference above recitals and finds that they are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby approves the Consultant Agreement between LAZ Parking CA, LLC and the City.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Consultant Agreement with LAZ Parking CA, LLC and make any minor amendments thereto.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and shall cause this resolution and this certification to be entered in the Book of resolutions of the Council of the City of Hawthorne.

SECTION 5. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption thereof.
