

RESOLUTION NO.8595

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-27 FUNDED BY
SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City, will receive an estimated \$2,328,747 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2026-27 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the tenth year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the City used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate and add active transportation infrastructure throughout the City this year and of similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in need of repair and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a better condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of Hawthorne, State of California, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The following list of newly proposed projects will be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2026-27 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

Construction and Construction Management

Project Title: Moneta Gardens Improvement Project

Project Description: The work consists of construction of ADA ramps, sidewalks, driveways, traffic striping including parking Ts, regrading of street surface, illuminated flashing stop signs, street storm water BMPs system

Project Location:

135th St. between Prairie Ave and Crenshaw Blvd

139th St. between Prairie Ave and Crenshaw Blvd

Cerise Ave. between 135th St and Rosecrans Ave.

Estimated Project Schedule: July 1 ,2026- June 30,2027

Estimated Project Useful Life: 20 years

Construction and Construction Management

Project Title: Imperial Hwy Improvement Project

Project Description: The proposed improvements include signal modifications, traffic coordination and timing upgrades, re-striping, utility work, reconstruction of adjacent concrete sidewalks, driveways, curbs and gutters required for the new signal project, including other general ADA improvement.

Project Location: Imperial Hwy between Prairie Ave and Inglewood Ave

Estimated Project Schedule: July 1 ,2026- June 30,2027

Estimated Project Useful Life: 20 years

Construction and Construction management

Project Title: Local Street Improvement Project 2026

Project Description: This Project will reconstruct selected streets at various locations. The project will rehabilitated streets in these areas using asphalt rubber hot mix over asphalt concrete leveling course to improve safety and drivability. This will include full depth reconstruction of specified areas as well as grinding, excavation and removal of existing pavement, new paving, and traffic striping and markings.

Project Location: Various local streets between Crenshaw and Aviation from east and west, and from Marine Ave to Imperial Highway from south to north.

Estimated Project Schedule: July 1, 2026- June 30, 2027

Estimated Project Useful Life: 10 years
