LAW ENFORCEMENT- COUNTER TERRORISM COURSE 2026

SUMMARY: Equip the LEO with relevant & useful counter-measures to combat a swarm type attack within their jurisdiction. The course purpose is to broaden the officer's scope of knowledge of enemy tactics, their reactions to counter measures, and their determination/fanaticism. It will also familiarize the officer with functional tactical leadership, terrain analysis, hasty planning and to develop methodologies to combat a coordinated multi-cell attack within their jurisdiction.

OBJECTIVES

- ♦ Enter and systematically clear a complicated residential and/or commercial structure that is occupied by a well equipped, well organized and fanatical terrorist cell with a small group of officers.
- ♦ Execute a coordinated deliberate, hasty, assault with support elements and multiple teams.
- ♦ Counter-assault armed suspects from a vehicle.
- ♦ Pursuit of multiple armed suspects on foot while in urban and open terrain.
- ♦ CBRN operations.
- ♦ Limited visibility operations.
- ♦ Sustain effective contact & disruption of the terrorist's goal(s) while managing casualties.
- ♦ Non-electronic Communication and Coordination TTP's.
- ♦ Stronghold domination techniques.
- ♦ Coordinate & Link-up with rapid response teams (uniform officers) on and/or IVO active terrorist cells in contact.
- ♦ Rapid & fluid (scalable) response to simultaneous attacks, both mobile & fixed, in variable terrain under adverse conditions.
- ♦ Proper coordination, training and use of Patrol Officers, and other Emergency Personnel, for active counter measures.
- ♦ Establish mind-set for the LEO to appropriately deter, counter & contain a homicidal paramilitary operation within their jurisdiction.

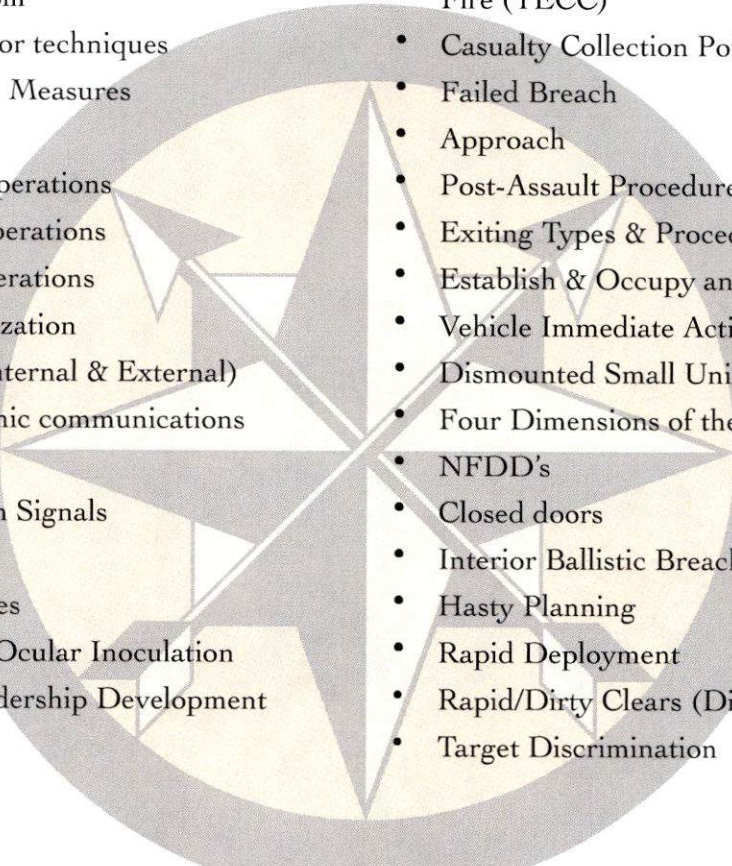

FIREARMS:

- 5.56mm Carbine
 - 8-12, 30rd magazines
 - Sling
 - Weapon mounted light
 - IRAD with eye-safe training screw
 - UTM/Sim drop in, bolt type conversion bolt
- Pistol
 - UTM/Sim conversion kit
 - 3-6 magazines
 - Belt secured holster
- Cleaning kit for carbine and pistol (bore-snake and rod kits are both recommended) with extra patches
- Bottle of acetone finger nail polish remover
- There is a DOD/DOJ approved armory onsite if required for weapons and sensitive items

INDIVIDUAL MUNITIONS AND EXPENDABLES:

- 5.56mm UTM/Sims/FoF munitions @ 2,500 rounds
- 9mm UTM/Sims/FoF munitions @ 500 rounds
- Green chemlight @ 84
- Red chemlight @ 12
- Blue chemlight @ 12
- Rubber bands - lightweight, package of 100
- Duct tape
- Electrical tape
- Spare batteries for firearm lights, IRAD, and NVGs

UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT:

- Tactical uniform and clothing suitable for training
- Footwear with ankle support
- Gore-Tex boots (recommended)
- Light weight Gore-Tex jacket
- 3-day or similar pack
- IFAK/BOK
- TQ's x2 (for training)
- NVG's with sacrificial lenses and mount (if available)
- IR strobe (if available)
- 8 feet of one-inch tubular nylon (earth tone/subdued color)
- Snap-link/Carabiner (full-sized)
- Tactical handheld light (Modlite, Surefire, etc)



INDIVIDUAL PACKING LIST - 2026

PPE:

- Ballistic helmet with NV shroud
- Wrap around ballistic eye pro (day/night)
- Peltor/ComTac/Sordin type ear pro (*must* cover ears & fit under helmet)
- Athletic cup
- Street hockey type throat pro
- Gloves (assault type)
- Elbow/Knee pads (optional)
- Tactical Body Armor (plate carriers are acceptable)
- Protective/Gas mask with filter and *clear* poly-carbonate protective outer lenses (x2 pairs recommended)

PERSONAL ITEMS:

- Full sized notebook
- Pens and pencils
- Small/Medium towel
- Personal first aid/Boo-boo kit
- Sports glide/ friction protection
- Anti-fog paste (Cat Crap)
- Lens cleaning cloth(s), disposable
- Insect repellent
- Nalgene bottle
- Canteen cup/Coffee mug
- Snacks, daily meals and water
- Allergy meds (high pollen and allergy area)
- Scissors/Shears
- Paint pen(s) and permanent marker
- Stand-alone battery for personal electronic devices (phone, etc)

GENERAL INFO:

Staging/Storage – A classroom with open lockers will be dedicated to the team and their equipment for the duration of the training. This building also has a dedicated refrigerator, microwave, and coffee pot for their use. A DOD/DOJ approved armory is also available for weapons and sensitive items storage if required.

Force on Force Conversion Kits - Simmunition® and UTM M4/M16 drop in, rifle conversion kits are available for course use at no additional charge. Reservation of the DARC kits will be on a first come basis.

Meals – Chow breaks are typically short. There will not be enough time during breaks to travel to town to eat. You should bring everything you need for food and hydration with you to training daily. It is recommended that all class participant's grocery shop on 'zero-day' night after the course prep for their food for the week. The dedicated classroom has a refrigerator, microwave, and coffee pot available for the class to use. It is also common for participants to bring a cooler with food.

Lodging – Here are some lodging options (all are 10-20 minute drive to the facility). You can also search for hotels in the McCain Blvd area of North Little Rock if you want something nearby.
