He continued to explain that for the last 2 years they had not given any raises in the Bureau of Internal & Child Health. Dr. Wilson informed the Court that with said line item transfer, they would like to give his 30 employees, who are working under the Bureau of Interna

Child & Health, a 5% salary increase effective November 1, 1990. He explained that said employees were falling behind and said there was unhappiness on the part of the employees who are working under that particular grant.

Mr. Vela informed the Court of a correction that needs to be made on the appropriation detail for Elida Silva, there's a typographical error. The proposal for 1991 is \$27,250.00 but should read \$27,300.00. He also moved on to include Olga Rodriguez who is an L.V.N. and has been so for a couple of years, her salary will be \$16,077.60. Dr. Wilson said this is all being transferred from one line item within the Maternal & Child Health Budget from contractual line item #82 into line item #03 and the Fringe Benefit line items. Monies from CO-PAY are not being used, it's all coming out of Contractual money.
