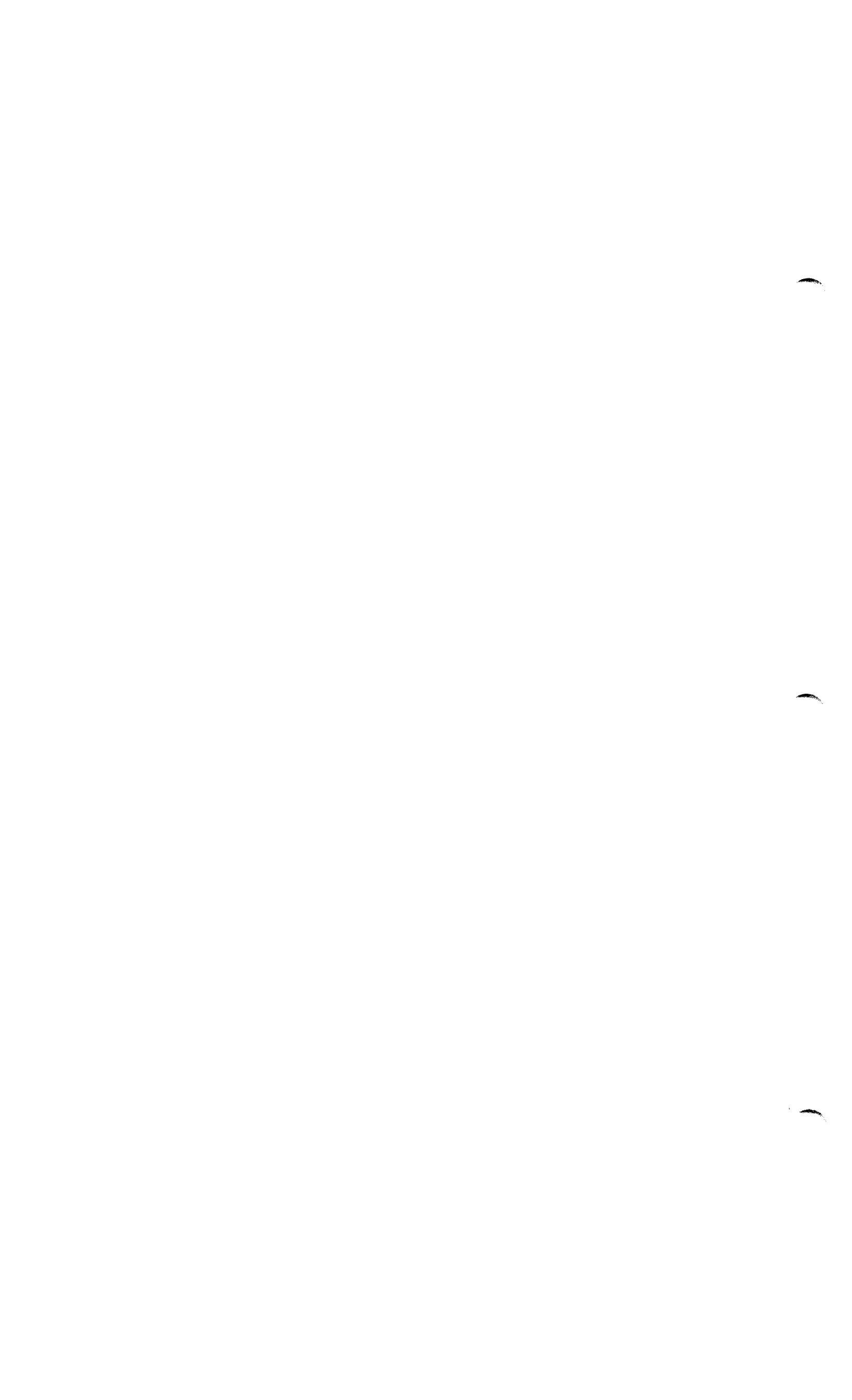

Mr. Bob Davis appeared before the Court and explained that this is the Law Library, that by Law, is required to be kept up to-date and informed the Court that all the books that they have are all out-dated by as much as 10 to 12 years. This will then be a purchase of all new books with the service that upgrades them on a yearly basis. He mentioned this cost would be coming out of the Commissary Fund and would not be a tax payer's burden.

A motion was made by Commissioner Arcaute, seconded by Commissioner Cavazos to authorize the advertisement for bids for the purchase of books for the County Jail Library and discussion followed:

Commissioner questioned the price of the books and asked if it was necessary to have said books. Commissioner Salinas felt the State was good at mandating the County to get said books and yet was not paying for the upkeep of their own prisoners and asked why the State wouldn't sue the County for not getting the books up-dated instead of making such mandates.

Bob Davis responded by saying that the ones who would sue the County would not be the State but would be the prisoners and this is what is trying to be avoided.

Following a continued discussion, Judge Ruiz requested Mr. Davis to submit a bid to purchase and an alternate bid to up-date the system on a yearly basis to see if the annual up-date could be bought.

Mr. Heister stated that the statutes are up-dated continuously and usually a pocket for them is used to place the current supplements.

Previous motion was made and seconded to authorize the advertisement for bids for the purchase of books for the County Jail Library. Bid opening December 12, 1990, bid award December 18, 1990.

These are monies that had been paid out and are being reimbursed by certain providers after clients were found to be eligible for a program such as the Medicaid Program and they would reimburse the Department.

Steve Austin continued to explain that these monies were reimbursements in access of existing appropriations.

Judge Ruiz felt that it would be appropriate for said monies to go back to General Fund so that said Department continues with the 10% at the point that the 10% be spent whether it be 9% and 1% SLEAIG or 10% and 0% they had because of other turnovers that this money should go to the General Fund.

Following a continued discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Salinas, seconded by Commissioner Cavazos, to appropriate unbudgeted funds and re-allocate budget - Indigent Health Care to Item 45 totaling \$12,576.05 and we have about eleven different accounts totaling \$347,528.26.

The \$70,000.00 is going to La Joya to help them with the Texas Parks & Wildlife Project and \$38,860.75 is going to Palmview to help them with the Texas Parks & Wildlife Project.

Commissioner Salinas asked if the City of Palmview had sent in a request for the \$38,000.00. He then asked Mr. Covacevich to give them a time limit of 1 week to make a decision.

Judge Ruiz hereby called this Public Hearing closed.

Anthony Covacevich presented Commissioners' Court with some information in regards to how the different cities were doing with their spending and handed out copies with said information of all three years of amount of money that's budgeted, obligated, re-programmed and then available.

Budgeted amount minus Administration on 1988 is \$5,468,999.17. Out of that amount only \$441,756.89 is Unobligated Balance to date. The largest of these is on La Villa (Community Center trying to be matched with EDA), the next highest is Edcouch (sewer project that was bid out and low bidder pulled out because they didn't award in time since Edcouch didn't have local funds to match said amount for project. Hidalgo has an Unobligated Balance of \$71,597.11.

On 1989 Urban County, budgeted amount minus Administration is \$5,641,000.00 and the Unobligated Balance is \$11,660,149.71. For Alamo, the Unobligated Balance is \$333,202.60 (match for EDA Sewer Plant), Alton the Unbudgeted Balance is \$292,967.92 (Sewer System the Water Dev. Board wants to implement) and La Villa has an unbudgeted balance of \$266,873.59 (majority of this is Housing Rehab).

The Year 3 for 1990, the budgeted Amount is for \$5,305,329.00 and have an unobligated balance of \$4,878,057.11. (year stated July 1st)

In subject of a different matter, Anthony Covacevich informed Commissioners' Court that Annette Nevarez has chosen to further her career and will be attending a University of her choice to obtain her Masters Degree and wished her the best of luck.

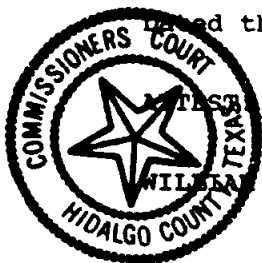
