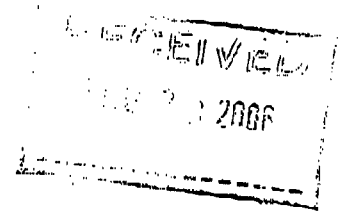

TRAFFIC SAFETY STUDY

In response to constituent concerns, Hidalgo County Precinct #4 requested a traffic safety study for the intersection of Cesar Chavez & Mile 17 Rd., Edinburg, Texas. The scope of work and associated fees for proposed traffic engineering services are based on the following items:

- a. TEDSI will submit three original duplicate study reports for the study to Hidalgo County Pct #4 by March 31, 2006.
- b. TEDSI will collect all necessary traffic data to study this intersection.
