Transportation of Elections Equipment and Supplies

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I. DESCRIPTION

Using 22' minimum length vans with power lift gates or ramps and tie down devices to prevent load shift, the contractor shall load at origin(s) and unload at destination(s) all required equipment as described herein and according to the schedules described herein. A minimum of two (2) employees per crew per van, and at least ten (10) vans at the 22' minimum length will be required per election. 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II. Terms & Conditions:

1. **SCOPE of CONTRACT:** The intention of this Request for Bid (RFB) for Hidalgo County is to receive bids for the moving of election equipment to be delivered to various voting sites and returned to Pharr Economic Development Corporation (Elections Dept. Storage Location), 1100 E. Business Hwy. 83, Pharr, Texas for one year beginning January 1, 2007. For Technical information concerning the products and/or services described in this RFB, please contact Michael Ramirez at, Hidalgo County Elections 956/318-2570.
2. **TERM CONTRACT:** The initial term of this contract shall commence upon award and expire on December 31, 2007 with Hidalgo County Commissioners Court sole discretion to extend for one (1) additional year, subject to approval by the Commissioners Court under the same firm fixed prices, terms and conditions.
3. **OPTION TO EXTEND:** Hidalgo County shall have the unilateral right to extend this Contract for one (1) additional year and two (2) additional one (1) month periods (individually, an "Option to Extend" and collectively, the "Options to Extend"), and all provisions of this Contract, except for term and price, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect. County shall exercise an Option to Extend no sooner than ninety (90) calendar days prior to expiration of the then current term. The total term of this Contract, included the Options to Extend, shall not exceed seventeen (17) months. County shall have the right to exercise all or portion of the Options to Extend in any combination it deems necessary.
4. **PRICE CHANGES:** The prices offered shall remain firm for the period of the contract. The prices offered shall also remain firm for the option year should the County choose to exercise the option to renew, except for changes that are industry wide and beyond the control of the contractor. If such changes do occur, it will be the responsibility of the contractor to provide documentation to Hidalgo County substantiating the changes to the bid process. Any price changes must be approved by Hidalgo County.
5. **METHOD OF AWARD:** Award, if any, will be made to
 - a. **Primary Vendor** the responsible bidder that submitted the lowest bid prices(s) as specified in Part I – Specifications and;

6. **PURCHASE ORDER:** Contractor will not supply or deliver any items until a purchase order number is assigned by the designated representative of the County Purchasing Office. Contractor will reference

purchase order and contract number on all invoices submitted to the Hidalgo County Auditor. The Contractor must respond by supplying and/or delivering the parts. Failure to act in this manner may result in termination of this contract.

HIDALGO COUNTY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CHANGE THE PICK UP LOCATION BUT TO KEEP THE LOCATION WITHIN HIDALGO COUNTY.

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9. **DELIVERY:** If delivery is required, all items must be packaged so as to be protected from damage during shipping and handling. Any item(s) damaged in shipping must be replaced in kind, or repaired, by the contractor, at the discretion of, and at no additional charge to, Hidalgo County.

10. **Market Volatility and Unit Price Adjustments:**

Hidalgo County recognizes that during periods of national crisis and unstable economic conditions, unforeseen price increases might affect costs for goods and services contracted on an annual basis. The following procedure may be employed to mediate price volatility:

- a. **Requesting Price Adjustment:** Upon written request of the Vendor to the County Purchasing Agent, the County may review evidence of prevailing industry-wide market conditions that warrant an adjustment in bid prices contained in the contract.
- A Vendor must tie any price change clause to an industry-wide or otherwise nationally recognized index, or some other form of verifiable document. Such written request must be accompanied by a certified copy of the supplier's advisory or notification to the vendor of the price changes.
 - The Vendor must put the Purchasing Agent on the mailing lists for such publications so that the Purchasing Agent can monitor said changes. Such membership shall be at no cost to the County.
 - The County Purchasing Agent retains the right to determine whether or not such proposed price changes are in the best interest of the County.
 - No price escalation will be authorized in excess of the amount of the increase referred to in the supplier's notice.
 - The County may only grant a price increase if the evidence presented is deemed reliable. Should the County allow a price increase, the approved price change shall be honored for all orders received by the vendor or contractor after the effective date of such price change. Approved price changes are not applicable to orders already issued and in process at time of price change.
- b. **Price Reduction:** Vendor shall notify the County at the time when the Vendor's costs for items and/or supplies reduce due to stabilization in the market at which time prices for items on this contract shall be reduced accordingly. Failure by the Vendor to notify the County of a decrease in costs for items and/or supplies for which the Vendor was granted a price adjustment, may result in immediate termination of this contract and the County shall not be obligated to pay the Vendor the difference between the contract price and the price adjustment.
- c. **Timeframe for Adjusted Price Increases:** Price increases are only valid for the quarter in which they are requested and approved. Prices shall return to the original contract price at the beginning of the following quarter unless a Vendor notifies the County in writing within ten (10) days of expiration of the quarter in which the price increase is in effect, that it desires to have the price increase continue or that the Vendor is requesting a different price increase for the following quarter. Such request must be supplemented with sufficient justification to demonstrate that the price increase remains necessary. The County Purchasing Department shall have sole discretion whether to grant the price increase extension. The County too, shall have discretion to unilaterally reduce, eliminate or extend a price adjustment to

the Vendor at any time upon written notice from the County to the Vendor demonstrating justification for such reduction, elimination or extension of the price adjustment.

- d. **Allowable Review Periods:** Price adjustment reviews may only be requested by the Vendor on a quarterly basis. However, the County may at its own discretion, conduct temporary price adjustment reviews at any time. The County Purchasing Agent and/or the County Auditor reserve the right to audit and/or examine any pertinent books, documents, papers, records or invoices relating directly to the contract transaction in question after reasonable notice and during normal business hours.
- e. **Dollar Limit to Price Changes:** The total increase in contract price shall not exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the original contract price during the contract term.
