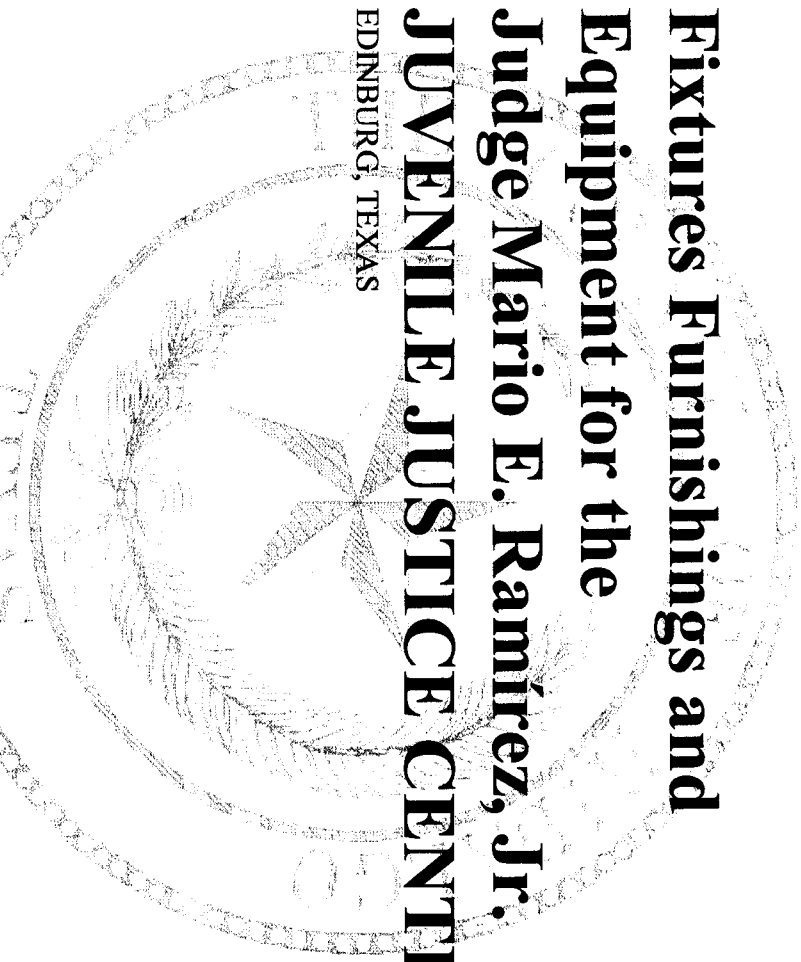

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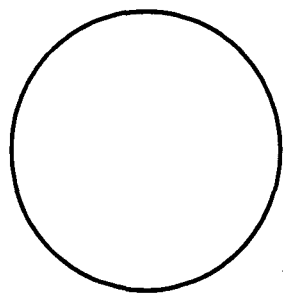

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DIVISION 1 - GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

01010 SUMMARY OF WORK:

1. SUMMARIES:

- 1.1 Location: Near the Northwest Corner of the Intersection of Richardson Blvd (F.M. 2128) and Doolittle Road, Edinburg, Hidalgo County, Texas
- 1.2 Cooperation: The Contractor, all other Contractors and all sub-contractors shall coordinate their work with all adjacent work and shall cooperate with all other trades so as to facilitate the general progress of the work. Each trade shall afford all other trades every reasonable opportunity for installation of their work and storage of their materials.
- 1.3 Inspection and Test: The Architect and his representatives shall at all times have access to the work whether it is in preparation or in progress. The Contractor shall Provide proper and safe facilities for such access and inspection. Make all inspections and tests in connection with this entire contract as required by the Architect. All testing shall be paid for by the Owner and be done by and independent testing laboratory meeting the approval of the Architect. Any cost of re-testing required due to failure of the Contractor at no expense to the Owner.
- 1.4 Checking Dimensions at site: Before ordering any materials or doing any work, Contractor shall verify all measurements of the building and be responsible for the corrections of them. No extras will be allowed for variations from drawings in existing conditions or for work performed under this contract. Any discrepancies found shall be submitted to the Architect for instructions before proceeding.
- 1.5 PROJECT MEETINGS
 - 1. Pre-Construction conference:
 - a. Will be scheduled by the Architect within five days after Notice to Proceed.
 - b. No work shall commence until this meeting has been successfully completed.
 - c. Attendance is mandatory for the Contractor and representatives of all subcontractors listed on the Proposal Form. Should any subcontractor not be in attendance, the meeting will be rescheduled. No allowances will be made for extensions of time due to any delay to the commencement of work caused by the absence of a subcontractor from this meeting.
 - 2. Progress Meetings:
 - a. Will be scheduled for the 15th of each month at the jobsite. (Unless otherwise agreed to by the Architect and Contractor)
 - b. Attendance-Architect, Contractor and all subcontractors which the Contractor deems necessary.

SECTION 01060 - PRELIMINARY CONSIDERATIONS

1. DEFINITIONS:

- a. References: References to known standard specifications in the Specifications shall mean and intend latest edition of such specification adopted and published at date of Advertisement for Bids.
- b. Reference to technical society, organization or body is made in Specifications in accordance with the following abbreviations:

- 2. PERMITS, LAWS, CODES, ETC.: Contractors shall comply with all Federal, State and local laws, codes, and ordinances applicable to the work and all requirements of the National Board of Fire Underwriters having jurisdiction. If the above laws, codes or ordinances conflict with Specification, then the laws, codes or ordinances shall govern except where Specification exceeds them in quality or quantity of materials or labor. Obtain and pay for all permits required in connection with the execution of the work. Under no circumstance shall any work be started before the required permits are obtained. Architect shall be furnished with certified copies of these permits if he so requests.

- 3. COOPERATION WITH BUILDING OFFICIALS: Cooperate with local and other governmental officials and inspectors at all times. If such official or inspector deems special inspection necessary, provide assistance and facilities that will expedite his inspection.

4. MANUFACTURER'S SPECIFICATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS:

- a. Install all manufactured items, materials and equipment in strict accordance with the manufacturer's recommended specifications, except that the Specifications herein, where more stringent, shall be complied with.
- b. At the completion of the project and prior to final acceptance by Owner, provide Owner with one complete set of operating and maintenance instructions, and demonstrate to him the procedures for proper operation and maintenance of all equipment.

- d. Sanitary Facilities for Workmen:
 - (1) Contractor shall provide and maintain suitable, weathertight, painted, sanitary toilet facilities for all workmen for the entire construction period. Comply with all requirements of applicable health authorities. When facilities are no longer required, Contractor shall remove from site.
 - (2) Contractor shall keep toilet facilities swept clean and supplied with toilet tissue at all times.
 - (3) If any new construction surfaces in the permanent project are soiled at any time, the entire area so soiled shall be completely removed from the project and rebuilt by Contractor at no additional expense to Owner.

 - e. Temporary Utilities: Shall be provided and paid for, complete, by the Contractor. Refer also to Division C requirements.

 - f. Weather Protection:
 - (1) Contractor shall at all times provide protection, including heating or cooling as necessary, against weather conditions, so as to maintain all work, materials, apparatus, and fixtures free from injury and damage. At the end of the day's work, all new work and stored material likely to be damaged by weather shall be covered or otherwise protected.
 - (2) Wet work shall not be performed when temperature is below 40 deg. F., or likely to go below 40 deg. F., within the ensuing 48 hours, except when sufficient protective heat is provided and Architect's approval in writing is obtained.
 - (3) Contractor shall construct and maintain all necessary temporary drainage and do all pumping necessary to keep excavation, floors, pits and trenches free of water.

 - g. Operation of Equipment: When heating, air conditioning, ventilating, exhaust or other items of mechanical, electrical or other equipment are installed, it shall be the responsibility of Contractor to operate same for a satisfactory period of time as required by Architect for proper testing of the equipment. Fuel, electric energy and all other utilities required for testing purposes shall be paid for by Contractor. Manufacturer's warranty of this equipment shall be dated from date of Issue of Certificate of Substantial Completion.

 - h. When any temporary facility is no longer needed for the proper conduct of the work, Contractor shall completely remove it from the project and shall repair or replace all material, equipment and finished surfaces damaged in doing so.

 - i. Scaffolding: All scaffolding shall meet the requirements of all Federal, State and local regulations and as required by the insurance carrier of the Owner and Contractor. Scaffolding shall be maintained at all times, as required, for the safety and protection of life and property.
9. PROTECTION: Provide barricades, fences, lights, etc., for protection of property and the public as required by local and/or State ordinances.

15. PROTECTION OF WORK AND PROPERTY AND INDEMNIFICATION

The CONTRACTOR shall continuously maintain adequate protection of all its work from damage and shall protect the OWNER'S property from injury or loss arising in connections with this CONTRACT. The CONTRACTOR shall indemnify, defend and save the OWNER harmless from and against any and all loss, costs, claims or liability for damages of any kind arising or alleged to have arisen from the negligent acts or omissions of the CONTRACTOR, its agents, employees or subcontractors to carry insurance as specified.

The CONTRACTOR shall take all necessary precautions for the safety of all persons on the Work and shall comply with all applicable provisions of Federal, State and Municipal safety Laws to prevent accidents an injury to persons on or adjacent to the premises where the Work is being performed. The CONTRACTOR shall erect and properly maintain at all items, as required by the conditions and progress of the Work, all necessary safeguards for the protection of workmen and the public, and shall post danger signs warnings against the hazards created by the various construction activities during the effective period of this CONTRACT.

In an emergency affecting the safety of life or of the Work or of adjoining property, the CONTRACTOR, without special instructions or authorization from the OWNER, is hereby permitted to act, at its discretion, to prevent such threatened loss or injury and the CONTRACTOR shall also act if instructed or authorized to do so by the OWNER.

16. INSPECTION OF THE WORK (AS APPLICABLE)

A. Authorized representative of the ARCHITECT shall at all times have access to the Work being performed, and the CONTRACTOR shall provide proper facilities for such access and shall give the ARCHITECT 24 hours advanced notice of when the Work will be ready for observation at the following status of construction broken down into major sections of the Construction Documents such as:

1. Observation of soil conditions after excavation for footings for building pad.
2. Observation of steel reinforcing before placement of concrete.
3. Observation of erection of structural steel components
4. Observation of electrical and plumbing rough-in before floor slab is poured.
5. Observation of roofing application as the roofing work is started.
6. Observation of electrical and plumbing rough-in before wall covering and ceiling are installed.
7. Final electrical, mechanical and plumbing observations.
8. Final observation of the completed project.

B. Intentional deviations from the Contract by the Contractor and/or his subcontractors, who know that it is unlikely for the Architect to discover such discrepancies during construction without in depth investigations, shall not be deemed to have been accepted when the Application is approved.

Approval of the Contractor's Application for Payment does not mean that approval has been granted for an installation not in compliance with the Contract Documents. It is the Contractor's duty and responsibility under the contract to comply with all of the provisions in the Contract.

4. Brochures and manufacturer's data shall include all special instructions regarding safety, installation sequences, and methods of assembly and installation.
5. Test data as required by various Sections of these Specifications including, but not limited to: soil, compaction of select fill, concrete, masonry mortar, structural welds, lumber, caulking and sealants, roofing, adhesives and coatings.
6. Items as noted on Drawings.
7. Items as specified under the various Sections of these Specifications.

2.00 PROCEDURES

- A. On first submittal, Contractor shall transmit (5) prints and one sepia to Architect and retain one print. Architect will retain prints and will stamp and return sepia to Contractor. After submittal has been reviewed, Contractor shall reproduce the number of copies needed for his use and for the use of his suppliers from the sepia.
- B. Follow same procedure for re-submittals as required for initial review.
- C. Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing contractors shall submit complete shop drawings showing all pipe runs, ducts, circuiting, take-offs, connections, etc. Shop drawings shall show cross sections of service and pipe chases, equipment floor plans, sections and elevations, duct details, pipe racks, hangers, pump and equipment foundations, sleeving diagrams, etc. Shop drawings shall be submitted for approval prior to ordering of any materials or fabrication of work. Complete piping diagrams of risers, runouts, etc., shall include flanges, fittings, valves, etc. Electrical layouts shall include circuit routing, mounting details, etc.

3.00 USE OF ARCHITECT'S DRAWINGS

- A. Contractors, Sub-Contractors and Material Suppliers shall not have use of electronic drawing or plot files of any Drawings (Civil, Structural, Architectural, Mechanical, Electrical, etc.) that make up part of these Contract Documents, for the purpose of preparing any submittals required by the Specifications.

4.00 STATUS OF SUBMITTALS

- A. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR:
 1. Timely transmission and scheduling of all submittals.
 2. Grouping of all submittals requiring color coordination.
 3. Reviewing all submittals for compliance with requirements of the drawings, specifications and general documents.

SECTION 01700 - PROJECT CLOSE OUT (AS APPLICABLE)

- 1.00 GENERAL: Applicable provisions of the General Documents and Specifications apply also to work under this Section.

- 2.00 DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS:
 - A. DEFINITIONS: Project close-out is hereby defined to include general requirements near the end of Contract Time, in preparation for final acceptance, final payment, normal termination of contract, occupancy by Owner and similar actions evidencing completion of the Work. Specific requirements for individual units of work are specified in sections of Divisions 2 through 16. General requirements at time of project completion are also set forth in General Conditions and Division 1.

 - B. DESCRIPTION : In anticipation of the completion of construction operations, the contractor shall, in compliance with project specification preparation, coordination, assembly and subsequent transmittal of project documents and records to the Architect for review as on of the prerequisites for certification of substantial completion and final payment.

 - C. PROJECT RECORDS AND DOCUMENT REQUIRED PRIOR TO SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION:

The required project records and documents for submittal prior to achievement of substantial completion shall include, but not necessarily be limited, to the following list of items (3) copies of each) bound in three (3), three ring binders, with the Project name, Owner's name, Architect's name, and Contractor's name.

 - 1. Provide a list of all sub-contractors and the major suppliers of materials for the project including their business address and telephone numbers, and contract person(s) for Warranty work.

 - 2. Obtain and deliver to Architect, for delivery to Owner, all special tools necessary for maintenance, operation, or monitoring of equipment apparatus.

 - 3. Obtain and deliver to Architect, all printed information regarding special treatment such as tile, glass, wall coverings, floor coverings, cabinets, countertops, woodwork, plastic/fiberglass/acrylic surfaces, hardware, plumbing fixtures, HVAC filter/equipment, and light fixtures.

 - 4. Typewritten record of all tests made of materials, equipment and systems. All such records shall state the date tests were conducted, and the names of all persons making and witnessing the tests, and citing unusual conditions relevant to the test. Documented tests shall include, but not be limited to the following:
 - 1. Appliance and Equipment Circuits
Verify proper voltages
Verify proper operation
Test all equipment and appliances

 - 5. Manufacturer's printed instruction manuals describing operating, servicing, maintenance

D. PROJECT RECORDS AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED PRIOR TO FINAL PAYMENT

The following project records and documents for submittal prior to final payment shall include, but not necessarily be limited to, the following list of items (3 copies of each):

1. Contractor's written certification that all punch list items have been completed.
2. Certification of Contractor's affidavit of payment of debts and claims, AIA G706A.
3. Certification of Contractor's affidavit of release of Liens, AIA G706A.
4. Certificate of consent of surety company to final payment, AIA G707.
5. Documents required by the General and Supplementary General Conditions.
6. Documents required by the General and Supplementary General Conditions.
7. Contractor's request for final payment.
8. Resolution of all allowances.

CLEANING UP: Leave all area in clean condition; remove from site all waste material, lumber, debris, etc. Glass windows to be thoroughly cleaned and washed, replace all broken glass. Building shall be left in a condition ready for occupancy by the Owner by the date of Substantial Completion fixed in the Notice to Proceed.

E. INSPECTION PROCEDURES:

1. Prior to requesting inspection:
 - a. Each Subcontractor shall make careful inspection of their work, and shall furnish a typewritten list of incomplete items to Contractor and Architect. Said list shall be specific as to room number, and location of incomplete or unacceptable condition.
 - b. Contractor or his superintendent shall review lists furnished by subcontractors, make a careful inspection personally of all areas scheduled for Substantial Completion, assuring that the work on that part of the Project is ready for Substantial Completion, prepare and submit a separate typewritten list of incomplete items to the Architect for review, and then notify in writing, the Architect and Owner, to make their inspection.
 - c. Prior to requesting inspection: Contractor or his superintendent shall make a careful inspection personally of all areas scheduled for substantial completion, assuring himself that the work on that part of the project is ready for Substantial Completion acceptance, and then notify, in writing, the Architect and Owner to make their inspection.
2. Initial Inspection: Upon receipt of Contractor's request, Architect will either proceed with inspection or advise Contractor of prerequisites not fulfilled. Following initial inspection, Architect will either prepare a Certificate of Substantial Completion or advise Contractor of work which must be performed prior to issuance of Certificate; and repeat inspection when requested to assure that work has been substantially completed. Results of completed inspection will form initial punch list for final acceptance.
3. If, at the end of the 30 days granted to Contractor for completion of all items on the punch list at the time of issuance of Substantial Completion, any items have not been

B. FINAL CLEANING:

GENERAL: Special cleaning for specific units of work is specified in Sections of Divisions 2 through 16. Contractor shall provide final cleaning of the work prior to final acceptance inspections, to a normal "clean" condition expected of a first-class building cleaning and maintenance service. Comply with material manufacturer's instructions for cleaning methods and materials. The following are items requiring cleaning, but not by way of work limitation or cleaning levels required. Contractor shall arrange and pay for:

- a. Removal of all non-permanent labels.
- b. Cleaning of all transparent and reflective materials, including mirrors, window and door glass, to a polished condition; removal of all substances which are vision-obscuring materials. Restore reflective surfaces to maximum reflective condition. Replacement of all broken glass and damaged transparent materials.
- c. Cleaning of exposed exterior and interior hard-surfaced finishes to a dirt and discoloration free condition to make items free of dust, stains, films and similar noticeable distracting substances. Restore reflective surfaces to maximum reflective condition.
- d. Wipe surfaces of mechanical and electrical equipment clean, including all similar equipment, remove excess lubrication and other substances.
- e. Remove debris and surface contamination's from all public and non-public spaces including roofs, plenums, shafts, stairways, trenches, equipment vaults, manholes, attics, and similar spaces.
- f. Broom clean and wet-mop exposed concrete floors, hard surface and resilient surfaced floors in all public and non-public areas.
- g. Vacuum clean all carpeted and similar soft-surface areas.
- h. Clean all toilet and plumbing fixtures and facilities to a sanitary condition, free of stains including those resulting from water splash disfiguration.
- i. Clean food service and similar equipment to a condition of sanitation, ready and acceptable for use. Clean light fixtures and lamps to be free of dust, debris and stains and as necessary to function with full lighting efficiency.
- j. Clean project site (yard and grounds), including landscape development areas, to be free of litter, construction debris and foreign substances. Sweep paved areas to a broom-clean condition and remove stains, petrochemical spills, and other foreign deposits. Rake grounds which are neither planted nor paved, to a smooth, even-textured surface.
- k. Contractor shall comply with safety standards and governing regulations for cleaning operations. Do not burn waste materials at site, or bury debris and excess materials on Owner's property. Discharge of volatile and other harmful and dangerous materials into drainage system shall be prohibited. Remove such waste materials from project site and dispose of in a lawful manner at no expense to Owner.

C. **REMOVAL OF PROTECTION:** Contractor shall remove temporary protection devices, coverings and facilities which were installed during course of the work to protect previously completed work during remainder of construction period.

D. Where extra materials of value remaining after completion of associated work have become Owner's property, Contractor shall store or otherwise arrange their disposition to Owner's best

advantage.

E. REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL PROCEDURES:

1. Solid debris, such as brick bats, mortar and plaster droppings and excess concrete shall be removed off project site from all areas within and about the building.
2. All scrap from lumber, crating, packing materials, paper and similar types of trash shall be removed from building and project site. Trash shall not be allowed to accumulate during construction for any period longer than one week. Contractor shall be responsible for a thorough clean up of building and its surroundings every week.

F. On completion of work and also just prior to final inspection, all floors shall be gone over with a dry mop, and all existing and new glass, whether in windows, doors, cabinets, or mirrors, shall be cleaned and polished and the entire job placed in a "spic and span" condition by Contractor for final inspection.

G. **REPLACING BROKEN GLASS:** It shall be the responsibility of Contractor to replace all broken glass, as it may occur before final acceptance of work.

The General Conditions, Supplementary Conditions, and General Requirements are a part of this division as if herein included.

SECTION 10010 - MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS1.00 GENERAL

- A. This Section is subject to the provisions and requirements of all Contract Documents.
- B. SUBMITTALS:
1. Refer to Division 1 for submittal requirements and procedures.
 2. Shop drawings are required for all items requiring fabrication and/or coordination with work of other Sections.
 3. Samples:
 - a. If requested by Architect, provide single samples of accessory and/or specialty items proposed for use on this project.
 - b. Samples submitted under this Section will be returned to Contractor when no longer required, and if approved, may be installed in the work.

2.00 PRODUCTS AND PROCEDURES

- A. ITEMS:
1. General: All items shall be accurately located, carefully plumbed and leveled, and securely and rigidly attached and reinforced as necessary. Use manufacturer's mounting devices as best suited to installation conditions, and as approved by Architect. All attachments shall be by mechanical means; cemented installation will **not** be accepted. Provide concealed grounds and backing where necessary .
 2. Metal Lockers: Staff shower lockers equal to Penco "VANGUARD," 12" W x 15" D x 36" H double tier, lowered doors, sloped tops, complete with hardware and trim, Z base, recessed handle with built-in combination lock, nameplate, filters, etc. See Drawings for locations.
 3. Metal Lockers: Provide and install Boys and Girls Intake lockers equal to Penco "VANGUARD," 12" W x 15"D x 12" H five (5) tier, lowered doors, sloped tops, complete with hardware and trim, Z base, recessed handle with built-in combination lock, nameplate, filters, etc. See Drawings for locations.
 4. Washer (W-1): Provide and install two (2) B & C Technologies 60lb Washer/Extractor Simple 30 programmable microprocessor control 200G Force 4 Liquid and Powder supply ready 200-240/60/1PH or 3PH 20 AMP. Model # HE60-1PH/3PH

period involving Owner's designated personnel. Representative must be capable of training personnel in the adjustment and operation of equipment including pertinent safety requirements, and instructing maintenance personnel in its operation, repair and upkeep. Instruction shall be given during the first week after the system has been accepted and turned over to the Owner for regular operation, except if equipment adjustment and/or repairs are required for its use. In such case, training sessions are not to occur until such adjustments and/or repairs have been completed and written documentation of said adjustments and/or repairs having been completed, furnished to Architect and Owner.

1. On-site instruction and training period will not exceed one (1) eight (8) hour day.

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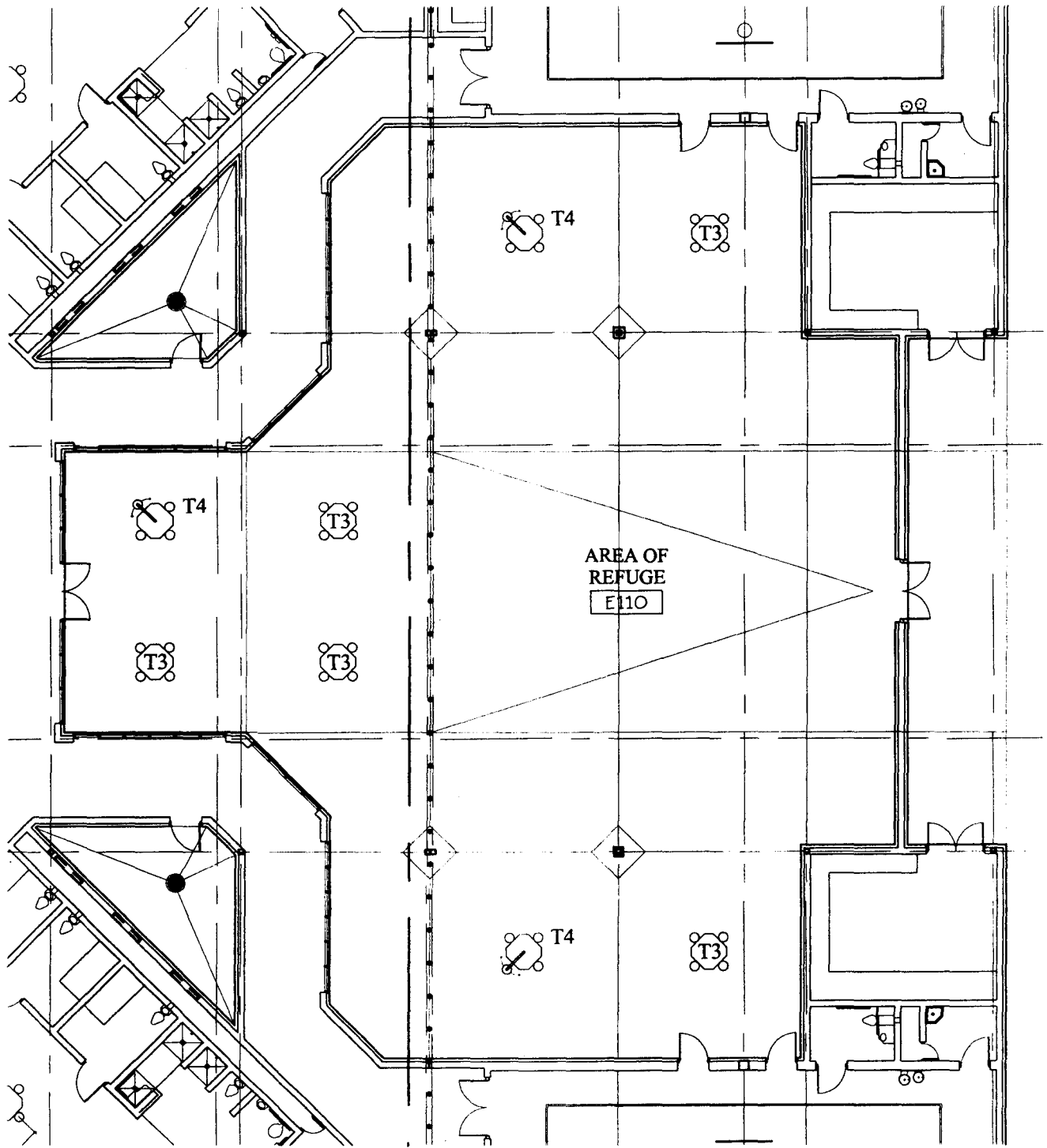
