

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Hidalgo County, that the Bureau of Assistance Operation Linebacker project be operated for the period of 05/01/06-04/30/07; and

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court understands that there is no matching fund requirement for the said project; and

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Bureau of Justice Assistance funds, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Texas Border Sheriff's Coalition (TBSC) in full.

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court designates Hidalgo County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court approved submission of the grant application for the Bureau of Justice Assistance Operation Linebacker to the Texas Border Sheriff's Coalition (TBSC).
