## RIDER CONTAINING DISCLOSURE NOTICE OF TERRORISM COVERAGE

This disclosure notice is required by the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act of 2002 (the "Act"). No action is required on your part. This Disclosure Notice is incorporated in and a part of the attached bond, and is effective the date of the bond.

You should know that, effective November 26, 2002, any losses covered by the attached bond that are caused by certified acts of terrorism would be partially reimbursed by the United States under a formula established by the Act. ## INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

### 1. Receipt and Opening of Bids

The Hidalgo County Pct. #3 (herein called the "Owner), invites bids on the form attached hereto, all blanks of which must be appropriately filled in. Bids will be received by the Owner at the Hidalgo County Purchasing Department until \_\_\_\_\_, and then at said office publicly open and read aloud. The envelopes containing the bids must be sealed, addressed to Martha Salazar, Hidalgo County Purchasing Agent at 100 E. Cano, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Edinburg, Texas and designated as Bid for Hidalgo County Pct. #3 Border Colonia Access Project.

The owner may consider informal any bid not prepared and submitted in accordance with the provisions hereof and may waive any informalities or reject any and all bids. Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof. Any bid received after the time and date specified shall not be considered. No bidder may withdraw a bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

### 2. Preparation of Bid

Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by Certification by Bidder Regarding Equal Employment Opportunity, Form, and Certification by Bidder (contractor), concerning Labor Standards and Prevailing Wage Requirements. All blank spaces for bid prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, in both words and figures, and the foregoing Certifications must be fully completed and executed when submitted.

Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelopes bearing on the outside the name of the bidder, his address, and the name of the project for which the bid is submitted. If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the bid must be enclosed in another envelope addressed as specified in the bid form.

### 3. Subcontracts

The bidder is specifically advised that any person, firm, or other party to whom is proposed to award a subcontract under this contract --

- a. Must be acceptable to the Owner after verification of the current eligibility status, and,

**8. Liquidated Damages for Failure to enter into Contract**

The successful bidder, upon his failure or refusal to execute and deliver the contract and bonds required within 10 days after he has received notice of the acceptance of his bid, shall forfeit to the Owner, as liquidated damages for such failure or refusal, the security deposited with his bid.

**9. Time of Completion and Liquidated Damages**

Bidder must agree to commence on or before a date to be specified in a Written "Notice to Proceed" of the Owner and to fully complete the project within \_\_\_\_\_ consecutive calendar days thereafter. Bidder must agree also to pay as liquidated damages, the sum of **\$250.00** for each consecutive calendar day thereafter as hereinafter provided in the General Conditions.

**10. Condition of Work**

Each bidder must inform himself fully of the conditions relating to the construction of the project and the employment of labor thereon. Failure to do so will not relieve a successful bidder of his obligation to furnish all material and labor necessary to carry out the provisions of his contract. Insofar as possible the contractor, in carrying out his work, must employ such methods or means as will not cause any interruption of or interference with the work of any other contractor.

**11. Addenda and Interpretations**

No interpretation of the meaning of the plans, specifications or other pre-bid documents will be made to any bidder orally.

Any and all such interpretations and any supplemental instructions will be in the form of written addenda to the specifications which, if issued, will be mailed by certified mail with return receipt requested to all prospective bidders (at the respective addresses furnished for such purposes), not later than three days prior to the date fixed for the opening of bids. Failure of any bidder to receive any such addendum or interpretation shall not relieve such bidder from any obligation under his bid as submitted. All addenda so issued shall become part of the contract documents.
