WORK AUTHORIZATION NO. 5

THIS WORK AUTHORIZATION is made pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section I.B. of the Agreement made by and between **HIDALGO COUNTY**, action herein by and through the **Commissioner's Court**, hereinafter called the "Owner," and, **TEDSI Infrastructure Group** professional engineers of Mission, Texas, hereinafter called "Engineer".

PART 1. SCOPE OF WORK

The purpose of this Work Authorization is for the Engineer to perform a spot-speed study at Rooth Rd between Schunior Rd and FM 1925.

The scope of services to be provided by the Engineer is identified in *Attachment "A" - Scope of Services to be Provided by the Engineer* attached hereto.

PART 2. LUMP SUM COST

The estimated cost for services under this Work Authorization is \$ 2,500.00 This amount is based upon the costs outlined in the Contract.

SCOPE OF WORK
TRAFFIC ENGINEERING SERVICES
SPOT SPEED STUDIES

In response to constituent concerns, Hidalgo County Precinct #4 requested spot speed studies at two locations. The scope of work and associated fee for proposed traffic engineering services is based on the following items:

- a. TEDSI will submit three original duplicate study reports for the study to Hidalgo County Pct #4 by December 6, 2007.
- b. TEDSI will collect all necessary speed data and pertinent traffic data to study this segment.
- c. TEDSI will provide recommendations for appropriate speed limits to be posted at the segment.
- d. Hidalgo County will provide accident reports for the segment.

SPOT SPEED STUDIES

TEDSI shall perform spot speed studies at this segment in Hidalgo County Precinct NO 4. TEDSI will collect the necessary speed data to perform the required analyses. A traffic engineering study report will be prepared which will include a summary of the conditions along the segments, collected speed information, analysis results and recommendations.

Segment to be studied:

1. Rooth Rd., between Schunior Rd and FM 1925.
