RE: **Pueblo de Palmas Phase 8 Subdivision – Pct. 3**
Final Approval with Financial Guarantee

Pueblo de Palmas Phase 8 is a ninety four (94) lot subdivision located approximately 4858 feet South of its intersection with Mile 7 Road (FM 2221) and Sago Palm Drive.

The proposed Subdivision lies within the Rural Area of the County.

The Drainage Report was submitted to, reviewed, and approved by the H.C.D.D. No. 1 Manager on August 24, 2004. The proposed subdivision lies within Zone "C" as per FEMA's FIRM.

The proposed subdivision plat will dedicate 23.50 feet on Mile 5 ½ Road of additional Road Right of Way in accordance with the Hidalgo County Thoroughfare Plan.

Sanitary Services will be provided by OSSF. Soil Analysis were conducted by Isidoro Gomez and approved by the Hidalgo County Environmental Health Department.

Water Services will be provided by La Joya Water Supply Corporation. There is an existing eight (8) inch waterline on Date Palm Drive, an existing eight (8) inch waterline on Queen Palm Drive and an existing ten (10) inch on Washington Palm Drive that will serve as the primary source of water for the proposed development.

The Subdivision Plat has been reviewed and complies with the Hidalgo County Subdivision Rules, Texas Water Development Board Model Subdivision Rules and the Texas Local Government Code.

The Subdivision received Preliminary Approval from the Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court on May 08, 2007. The Subdivider is requesting Final Approval with Financial Guarantee. A Letter of Credit from Texas State Bank in the amount of \$232,375.50 was submitted to the Planning Department and addressed to the County Judge and County Commissioner's Court. The Letter of Credit will be used to secure the funds for the paving improvements and the installation of ninety four (94) septic tank systems.

The Hidalgo County Advisory Board convened and recommended **Final Approval with Financial Guarantee on November 06, 2007.**
