

**TRAFFIC ENGINEERING SERVICES**  
**MULTI-WAY STOP WARRANT STUDY**

In response to constituent concerns, Hidalgo County Precinct #3 requested a multi-way stop warrant study at FM 494 (Shary Rd) at Mile 7 ¼ (Old SH 107). The scope of work and associated fee for proposed traffic engineering services is based on the following items:

- a. TEDSI will submit three original duplicate reports of study to Hidalgo County Precinct #3. Reports will be submitted thirty days after approval of Work Order by Commissioner's Court.
- b. TEDSI will analyze existing traffic control.
- c. TEDSI will collect vehicle and pedestrian volumes.
- d. TEDSI will determine major street travel speed, if necessary.
- e. TEDSI will analyze accident data, if necessary.
- f. Hidalgo County will provide accident reports, if necessary.

**MULTI-WAY STOP WARRANT STUDY**

TEDSI shall perform multi-way stop warrant study at FM 494 (Shary Rd) at Mile 7 ¼ (Old SH 107) in Hidalgo County Precinct #3. TEDSI will collect the necessary traffic volumes to perform the required analyses. A traffic engineering warrant study report will be prepared which will include existing conditions, vehicle and pedestrian volumes, analysis and recommendations (if necessary, report will address major street travel speed and accident data)
