

SCOPE OF SERVICES
TRAFFIC ENGINEERING SERVICES
MULTI-WAY STOP WARRANT STUDY

In response to constituent concerns, Hidalgo County Precinct #3 requested a left turn warrant study at Mile 4 Rd at Bentsen Palm Dr. The scope of work and associated fee for proposed traffic engineering services is based on the following items:

- a. TEDSI will submit three original duplicate reports of study to Hidalgo County Precinct #3. Reports will be submitted thirty days after approval of Work Order by Commissioner's Court.
- b. TEDSI will analyze existing traffic control.
- c. TEDSI will analyze vehicle movements at the intersection
- d. TEDSI will analyze vehicle delays, if necessary.
- e. TEDSI will analyze vehicle conflicts, if necessary.
- f. Study does not include capacity analysis
- g. Hidalgo County will provide accident reports, if necessary.

LEFT TURN WARRANT STUDY

TEDSI shall perform a left turn warrant study at Mile 4 Rd-Bentsen Palm Dr in Hidalgo County Precinct #3. TEDSI will collect the necessary field information to perform the required analyses. A traffic engineering study report will be prepared which will include existing conditions, analysis and recommendations.


