Job Title: Bulldozer Operator

SUMMARY:

Employee will be responsible for operating dozer at job sites throughout the County's facilities.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE:

- High school diploma or GED preferred.
- Ability to operate and maintenance of dozer, good eye-sight and depth perception.
- Follow written/oral instructions.
- Ability to work with a crew.
- Ability to read/write the English language.
- Bilingual preferred.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Shall be responsible for clearing area within the County's jurisdiction.
- Clearing and leveling drainage easement.
- Spread soil along drainage easement when required.
- Work near water, high places and slippery and uneven surfaces.
- Assist haul truck operator in loading and unloading dozer when being relocated.
- Inspects equipment for proper functions and safety requirements on a daily basis.
- Traveling from site to site.
- Ability to perform and/or assist mechanic with proper mechanical maintenance of dozer.

OTHER SKILLS and ABILITIES:

- Must be able to work extended hours during emergency circumstances; related to weather conditions.
- Will be exposed to environmental elements/weather while working.
- Must be able to sustain 6-7 hours of continuous work requiring sitting for long periods of time.
- Being able to endure tractor motion, exposure to noise, dust and dirt and working in high places.
- Employee may be assigned other duties in addition to those listed; duties may change according to the changing needs of the County.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is required to talk or hear. The employee is required to stand. The employee is required to walk; sit; use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; stoop, and kneel.

The employee must occasionally lift and/or move over twenty-five (25) pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.

WORK ENVIRONMENT:
