RE: **Cardinal Star Subdivision– Pct. 4**
Final Approval with Financial Guarantee

Cardinal Star is a thirty four (34) lot subdivision located on the North side of Benito Ramirez Road approximately 300 feet East of Cesar Chavez Road.

The proposed Subdivision lies within the City of Edinburg E.T.J. and was approved by the Planning and Zoning and City Commission of said City.

The Drainage Report was submitted to, reviewed, and approved by the H.C.D.D. No. 1 Manager on January 20, 2008. The proposed subdivision lies within a Zone "X" as per FEMA's FIRM.

The proposed subdivision plat will dedicate ten (10) feet on Benito Ramirez Road of additional Road Right of Way in accordance with the Hidalgo County Thoroughfare Plan.

Sanitary Sewer Services will be provided by OSSF. Soil Analysis Test were conducted by Jose A. Gonzalez and approved by the Environmental Health Department. Twenty Nine (29) septic tank systems have been installed, inspected and can be expected to function satisfactorily.

Water Services will be provided by North Alamo Water Supply Corporation. There is an existing eight (8) inch waterline on Benito Ramirez Road that will serve as the primary source of water for the proposed development.

The Subdivision Plat has been reviewed and complies with the Hidalgo County Subdivision Rules, Texas Water Development Board Model Subdivision Rules and the Texas Local Government Code.

The Subdivision Plat received Preliminary Approval from the Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court on May 19, 2008. The Subdivider is requesting Final Approval with Financial Guarantee. A Cash Deposit in the amount of \$5,000.00 was submitted to the Planning Department and deposited into Escrow Account No. 08-1100-211-00-000-018-0-000. The Cash Deposit will be used to secure the funds for the installation of Five (5) septic tank systems.

The Hidalgo County Advisory Board convened and recommended **Final Approval with Financial Guarantee on November 03, 2008.**
