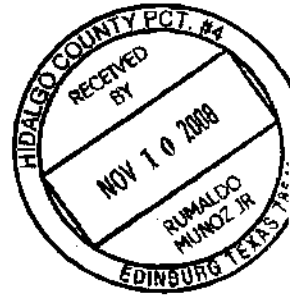

PART 1. SCOPE OF WORK

The estimated cost for services under this Work Authorization is \$ 2,000.00. This amount is based upon the costs outlined in the Contract.

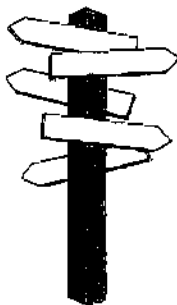

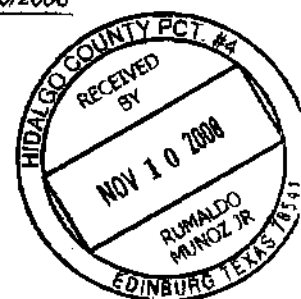

SCOPE OF WORK

TRAFFIC ENGINEERING SERVICES

In response to Edinburg Consolidated Independent School District, JFK Elementary School Principal concerns, Hidalgo County Precinct #4 requested a multi-way stop study for the intersection of *Tex Mex Rd @ 87th St east of San Carlos, Texas*. The scope of work and associated fee for proposed traffic engineering services is based on the following items:

- a. TEDSI will submit two original duplicate study reports for the study to Hidalgo County Pct #4 approximately 30 days after a Notice to Proceed is received by TEDSI.
- b. TEDSI will collect all necessary traffic data to study the intersection.
- c. TEDSI will provide recommendations to enhance traffic operations and safety at the intersection.

MULTI-WAY STOP STUDY

TEDSI shall perform a multi-way stop study at this intersection in Hidalgo County Precinct No. 4. TEDSI will collect the necessary traffic data to perform the required analysis. The multi-way stop warrants as outlined in the 2006 TMUTCD will be utilized for this study. A traffic engineering study report will be prepared which includes a summary of the conditions at the intersection, multi-way stop warrant analysis results, recommendations, and project photographs.

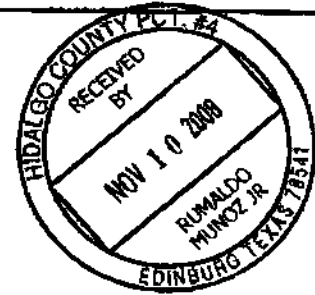

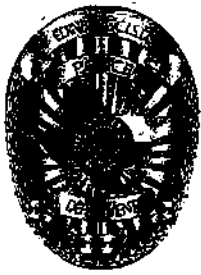

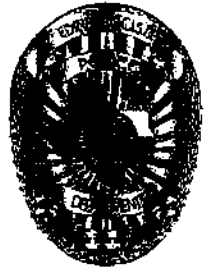

Re: Recommendation for School Safety at J.F.K. Elementary Surroundings

The Principal Mrs. B. Figarelli from J.F.K. Elementary School has indicated some safety concerns regarding that campus. Items of concerns are as follows:

1. Crosswalks at 87th Street and TexMex Rd., needs repainting for the students that utilize the crosswalk.
2. 87th Street and TexMex Rd. to be a three way stop sign controlled intersection.
3. Needs blinking orange beacon to indicate reduced speed due to school zone. This would need to be set up on TexMex Rd.
4. Sidewalk from 87th street to 83rd St. so students can walk on instead of walking in the street.
