**SERVICE CONTRACT  
C-07-195-04-10**

THIS CONTRACT is made and entered into this 10<sup>th</sup> day of **April, 2007** by and between the **COUNTY OF HIDALGO, TEXAS** (“County”), and **Sign Language Interpreters LLC** a Limited Liability Corporation, d/b/a **A Sign Language Company** (“Company”)

WHEREAS, Company responded to advertised notices for bids for “Qualified Interpreting Services” (the “Services”); and

WHEREAS, Company submitted a bid to provide services in accordance with the specifications as bid, a copy of such specifications and bid being attached hereto as Exhibits “A” respectively, and incorporated herein for all purposes (the “Specifications”); and

WHEREAS, in recognition of and in consideration of Company’s agreement to perform the Services in accordance with Specifications, the Commissioners Court of County awarded the bid to Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, in mutual consideration of the foregoing and the further consideration of the following, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. County and Company hereby agree that this Contract is entered into in order to provide the Services to Hidalgo County for a eight(8) month term with the County’s option to extent an additional one (1) year term This contract does not extend to any third parties any duties or benefits conferred in any manner hereunder or otherwise.

2. Company hereby promises and agrees to render and provide, during the term of this Contract, and shall be obligated to render and provide the Services in accordance with the specifications within Hidalgo County. Company agrees in performing the Services that it will use proper professional standards, comply with any and all appropriate laws and regulations in providing the Services, and devote such time as is necessary to safety and efficiently provide the Services.

3. This Contract shall be for a period beginning **April 10, 2007** and ending on **December 31, 2007** and may be extended at the sole discretion of County for an additional ninety (90) days, unless this Contract is terminated pursuant to the provisions herein, whichever occurs first. Hidalgo County reserves the right to extend the contract for an additional year.

4. As a condition of this Contract, Company shall hold and maintain throughout the term of this Contract all licenses and permits required or which may be required by any authority

during the term hereof to provide the Services.

5. All trucks or vehicles operated by the Company to perform the Services shall contain all equipment required by any authority to operate on streets and roads and all persons in the employ of Company who operate such trucks or vehicles shall have the require licenses, qualifications, skill and expertise to perform such Services and shall comply with all laws, rules and regulations prescribed by any agency or authority having jurisdiction with regard to the operation os such trucks or vehicles in providing the Services.

6. As consideration for rendering the Service provided for in this Contract, the County agrees to pay Company the amounts specified in Exhibit "B" attached hereto payable against written invoice submitted by Company.

7. Company shall provide insurance in force on all its vehicles and all persons connected with providing services under this Contract naming County as an additional insured (with the coverages and in the amounts described on Exhibit "C" attached hereto and incorporated herein at this point for all purposes), and shall furnish to county certificates of such insurance coverage.

8. Company shall provide a sufficient number of trucks, vehicles, personnel and equipment available to safety and efficiently provide the Services.

9. Company shall indemnify and hold harmless County, its elected officials, employees and agents from any and all claims, damages, losses and expenses including attorney's fees for the defense of any action against County arising out of, resulting from, or connected with the provision of the Service by Company under this Contract. Said indemnity shall cover any act or failure to act by the Company, its agents or employees.

10. This Contract shall not be assignable in whole or in part by either party without prior written consent of the other party.

11. It is expressly agreed that this Contract and the performance by the parties hereunder does not create any agency relationship or master-servant relationship, that County has no supervision of the performance of the Services provided by Company and that Company is an independent contractor under this Contract.

12. Any notice required or permitted to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be delivered personally or sent by certified mail, postage prepaid, as set for below:

13. In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision thereof and this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.

14. This Agreement may be terminated by either party without cause upon thirty (30) days written notice.


15. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of and be enforceable by the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors and assigns where permitted by this Agreement.

16. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and shall be performable in Hidalgo County.


**Commitment of Current Revenues Only.** In the event that, during any term hereof, the Commissioners Court does not appropriate sufficient funds to meet the obligations of Buyer under this Agreement, Buyer may terminate this Agreement upon ninety (90) days written notice to Seller. Buyer agrees, however, to use reasonable efforts to secure funds necessary for the continued performance of this Agreement. The parties intend this provision to be a continuing right to terminate this Agreement at the expiration of each budget period of Buyer pursuant to the provisions of Tex. Loc. Govt. Code Ann. § 271.903 (Vernon Supp. 1996).





**Exhibit "A"**  
**Qualified Interpreting Services**

**Request for Qualifications/Proposals**

**REQUIREMENTS**

**I. SCOPE OF SERVICES**

Hidalgo County will receive sealed qualifications/proposals with a turnkey solution for the provision of sign language interpreting services for a one (1) year period, with the County's sole discretion to extend the contract for an additional one (1) year for deaf or hard of hearing County employees', prisoners, defendants and citizens dealing with the County on a routine or emergency basis.

If, during the life of the contract, the successful proposer's net prices generally available for items awarded are reduced or below the contracted price, it is understood and agreed that the benefits of such reduction be extended to the County.

The intent of this solicitation is to acquire the services of a sign language interpreting firm (Contractor) for all County agencies on an as-needed and emergency basis.

More than one award may be made under this solicitation to assure complete coverage for the County's needs throughout the contract term.

**II. DUTIES OF THE CONTRACTOR**

The Contractor shall:

1. Provide a means of contacting the Contractor for the required services on a 24-hour basis.
2. Maintain a staff of certified interpreters who will be able to respond to emergency needs 24 hours each day with a 2-hour response time.
3. Maintain such records as may be required by the specialized needs of the various County departments requiring the services.
4. Provide certified interpreting services when requested by authorized personnel for a variety of situations including, by way of illustration and not limitation:
  - A. Personnel Issues
  - B. Law enforcement related matters
  - C. Health and mental health clinic visits
  - D. Social services needs
  - E. Engineering/technical meetings/workshops
  - F. Staff meetings
  - G. Public meetings
5. Work closely with County personnel to ensure full participation by all deaf or hard of hearing persons in the relationships with the County.
6. Maintain adequate interpreting resources to cover all assignments made with advance notice. Bidders shall provide County with all data about their interpreting pool including number of interpreters available, number of certified interpreters, number certified interpreters with legal specialization, and the names of the primary people and their certification level, who will be providing services under this contract.
7. Maintain a schedule of "on call" certified interpreters who will respond promptly to emergency needs 24 hours each day with a 2-hour response time.

8. Guarantee that each interpreter assigned is certified to provide the highest quality of communication for the situation and for the individual(s) being served.
9. Maintain a detailed record regarding each assignment placed against the contract.
10. Work with County representatives on procedure and periodic reviews of the system and its effectiveness.
11. If in any event, a department requires more than two hours of interpreting services, the offeror must provide a second interpreter as a back up and relief.

### III. INTERPRETING SERVICES

#### 1. NON-EMERGENCY SERVICES

Requests for guaranteed services will be made by authorized County personnel to the contractor at least 5 business days in advance of the assignment date. Failure by Contractor to honor the promised assignment date for any reason, shall result in the provision of a like period of services for the County at no charge. A pattern of failure to honor scheduled assignments may result in contract termination.

When making requests, authorized County personnel will provide the following information:

- Date, time and expected duration of the assignment.
- Location (street address, room number) of the assignment.
- Name and phone number of an on-site contact person.
- Special information pertinent to the appropriate placement of an interpreter (type of meeting, communication preference of the client).
- Name of deaf or hard of hearing client(s) when possible.
- Number of interpreters required.

When less than five (5) days notice is provided, the Contractor will follow the procedures listed above in so far as practical.

All authorized requests for interpreting services will be faxed to the Contractor, who will confirm receipt of interpreting request by phone or fax.

#### 2. CANCELLATION POLICY

Notification of cancellations made by the County within a two (2) hour minimum notice before the schedule event will be billed by the Contractor at the rate agreed upon during the intake.

#### 3. EMERGENCY SERVICES NETWORK

When an emergency situation arises, the department staff or designated representative will call the Contractor's emergency telephone number, and request the emergency services of a certified on-call interpreter.

The contractor must be able to provide interpreters within two (2) hours of receiving request for emergency services.

#### 4. BASIC INTERPRETING SERVICES

Offerors shall indicate in the proposal their pricing schedule for the various services required. The hourly rates paid to the interpreter shall be on a cost per hour of interpreting services from the time that the interpreter arrives at the scene or the time of the appointment previously scheduled until completion of the interview. No travel or portal to portal rates will be accepted by the County. Pricing for on-site interpreting services shall be based on the schedule in the proposed form enclosed. No more than one interpreter shall be sent in response to a service request unless the use of additional interpreters is pre-approved and ordered by the requesting department.

**IV. ADDITIONAL COSTS (IF ANY)**

Offerors shall indicate any additional costs required to provide the described services to the County. Such costs may include a flat rate annual fee (retainer) covering all administrative and other costs necessary to provide the services.

**V. ADDITIONAL SERVICES AVAILABLE See attached**

The offeror shall indicate, as a separate attachment to the proposal, any additional services and their cost which may be available to the County, e.g. real time captioning, sign language instruction. The additional services proposed will not be considered a criterion for award but are requested in the event a contract is established with that offeror and the County desires to take advantage of such additional services.

**VI. STAFFING See attached.**

The offeror shall provide with its response:

- A. Type(s) of certification held by the interpreters
- B. The extent of training and evaluation of interpreters provided by the Contractor
- C. A discussion on the Contractor's quality control program.

**VII. PRICE ADJUSTMENTS**

The Contract unit prices will remain firm for one (1) year with Hidalgo County's sole discretion to extend the contract for an additional one (1) year.

**VIII. PAYMENT PROCEDURES**

The Contractor will prepare a detailed invoice for services rendered. This billing will be submitted on the basis of interpreting costs plus any additional services provided during any given month. Emergency calls under this network will be included on the detailed invoices submitted to the County Department.

**IX. EVALUATION**


The Contract and a representative of the County will meet to evaluate, every four (4) months of the Contract Term, the extent to which the Contractor is satisfying the interpreting needs of the County Departments.

**QUALIFICATIONS**

The proposer must have the following qualifications but not limited to the following:

- A. Be regularly engaged in the sign language interpreting business.
- B. Have available under direct supervision and employment, the necessary organization and facilities to properly fulfill the services required in a timely manner.
- C. Have available certified interpreters with the minimum of two years experience in sign language interpretation for the hearing impaired.
- D. Provide certified interpreters to perform sign language interpretation fluently. Hidalgo County reserves the option to request replacement interpreter(s) after the service period has begun if necessary; and at any other time deemed necessary.
