

RESOLUTION

A Resolution Of The Commissioners' Court Of The County Of Hidalgo, Texas, Requesting That The Office Of Rural Community Affairs (ORCA) Revisit The Allocation/Distribution Formula For The State Of Texas Plan For Disaster Recovery Program

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of the County of Hidalgo desires to participate in the State of Texas Plan for Disaster Recovery as funded by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, these conditions were caused by the impact of Hurricane Dolly, a Category 2 storm; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Hidalgo to request and obtain funding for the Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council (LRGVDC) Region based on the overall damage caused by Hurricane Dolly to all of Hidalgo County, and

WHEREAS, the increase in funding will allow the County to repair its damaged infrastructure while proactively improving its critical infrastructure, such as drainage, roads and buildings,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF THE COUNTY OF HIDALGO, TEXAS:

1. That a request be submitted to the Office of Rural Community Affairs (ORCA) to revisit the formula used for the distribution and/or allocation of Disaster Recovery Program funds.
