Please find attached copies of the required certification certificates for our key Technical Services people, per your email request of 1 January 26, 2009.



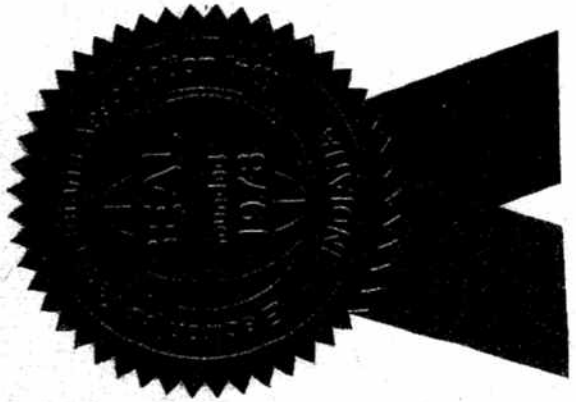

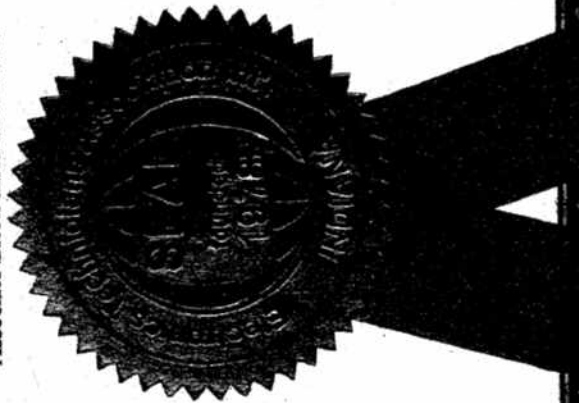
