RE: **Franco Reyes Acres Subdivision– Pct. 4**
Final Approval

Franco Reyes Acres Subdivision is a two (2) lot subdivision located on the West side of Cesar Chavez Road, approximately 660 feet North of Trenton Road.

The proposed Subdivision lies within the City of Edinburg E.T.J. and was approved by the Planning and Zoning and City Commission of said City.

The Drainage Report was submitted to, reviewed, and approved by the H.C.D.D. No. 1 Manager on February 11, 2007. The proposed subdivision lies within Zone "B" as per FEMA's FIRM.

The proposed subdivision plat will dedicate twenty (20) feet on Cesar Chavez Road of additional Road Right of Way in accordance with the Hidalgo County Thoroughfare Plan.

Sanitary Services will be provided by OSSF. Soil Analysis Test were conducted by Jose Angel Gonzalez and approved by the Hidalgo County Environmental Health Department. All septic tank systems have been installed, inspected and can be expected to function satisfactorily.

Water Services will be provided by North Alamo Water Supply Corporation. There is an existing eight (8) inch waterline on Cesar Chavez Road that will serve as the primary source of water for the proposed development.

The Subdivision received Preliminary Approval from the Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court on November 13, 2007. The Subdivision Plat has been reviewed and complies with the Hidalgo County Subdivision Rules, Texas Water Development Board Model Subdivision Rules and the Texas Local Government Code.

The Hidalgo County Advisory Board convened and recommended **Final Approval** on **March 24, 2009**.
