**SERVICE CONTRACT**  
**C-08-015-04-29**

**THIS CONTRACT** is made and entered into this 29<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2008 by and between the **COUNTY OF HIDALGO, TEXAS** ("County"), and **Bernardo Saenz, Jr., d/b/a Universal Truckers, Inc.** a Texas Corporation. ("Company").

**WHEREAS**, Company responded to advertised notices for bids for "**Hauling Services for All Road Materials**" for **Hidalgo County Precinct No. 1** (the "Services"); and

**WHEREAS**, Company submitted a bid to provide services in accordance with the specifications as bid, a copy of such specifications and bid being attached hereto as Exhibits "A" and "B" respectively, and incorporated herein for all purposes (the "Specifications"); and

**WHEREAS**, in recognition of and in consideration of Company's agreement to perform the Services in accordance with Specifications, the Commissioners Court of County awarded the bid to Company.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in mutual consideration of the foregoing and the further consideration of the following, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. County and Company hereby agree that this Contract is entered into in order to provide the Services to locations at **Hidalgo County Precinct No. 1**. This Contract does not extend to any third parties any duties or benefits conferred in any manner hereunder or otherwise.
2. Company hereby promises and agrees to render and provide, during the term of this Contract, and shall be obligated to render and provide the Services in accordance with the

Specifications within **Hidalgo County** following a request for Services by the **Hidalgo County** or his designated agent. Company agrees in performing the Services that it will use proper professional standards, comply with any and all appropriate laws and regulations in providing the Services, and devote such time as is necessary to safely and efficiently provide the Services.

3. This Contract shall be for a period of one (1) year with the County's option to extend for an additional one (1) year period "**On An As Needed Basis**" under the same rates, terms and conditions. (Prices must remain firm during the contract term). County also reserves the right to continue this bid for an additional sixty (60) day Grace Period, under the same rates terms and conditions.

4. As a condition of this Contract, Company shall hold and maintain throughout the term of this Contract all licenses and permits required, or which may be required by any authority during the term hereof to provide the Services.

5. All trucks or vehicles operated by the Company to perform the Services shall contain all equipment required by any authority to operate on streets and roads and all persons in the employ of Company who operate such trucks or vehicles shall have the required licenses, qualifications, skill and expertise to perform such Services and shall comply with all laws, rules and regulations prescribed by any agency or authority having jurisdiction with regard to the operation of such trucks or vehicles in providing the Services.

6. As consideration for rendering the Service provided for in this Contract, the County agrees to pay Company the amounts specified in Exhibit "B" attached hereto payable against written invoice submitted by Company.

7. Company shall provide insurance in force on all its vehicles and all persons connected with providing services under this Contract naming County as an additional insured (with the coverages and in the amounts described on Exhibit "C" attached hereto and incorporated herein at this point for all purposes), and shall furnish to County certificates of such insurance coverage.

8. Company shall provide a sufficient number of trucks, vehicles, personnel and equipment available to safely and efficiently provide the Services.

9. Company shall indemnify and hold harmless County, its elected officials, employees and agents from any and all claims, damages, losses, and expenses including attorney's fees for the defense of any action against County arising out of, resulting from, or connected with the provision of the Service by Company under this Contract. Said indemnity shall cover any act or failure to act by the Company, its agents or employees.

10. This Contract shall not be assignable in whole or in part by either party without prior written consent of the other party.

11. It is expressly agreed that this Contract and the performance by the parties hereunder does not create any agency relationship or master-servant relationship, that County has no supervision of the performance of the Services provided by Company, and that Company is an independent contractor under this Contract.

12. Any notice required or permitted to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be delivered personally or sent by certified mail, postage prepaid, as set forth below:

13. In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision thereof and this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.


14. This Agreement may be terminated by either party without cause upon thirty (30) days written notice.


16. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and shall be performable in Hidalgo County.





EXHIBIT “A”**

**SECTION I - SPECIFICATIONS**

It is intended that all hauling of road materials will be within Hidalgo County Precinct # 1 - Zone A, Zone B, and Zone C and will be awarded on a per ton basis, per mile radius. This bid price will be for the duration of one (1) year with the County's option to renew for an additional one (1) year. Hauling services will be on an “As Needed Basis” by the precinct.

1. Road materials (i.e. crushed, sand, gravel, hot mix, cold mix) will be hauled from vendor pits that are currently holding the contract for material bids. Vendors stated are presently on Contract for the materials, however, vendors may change due to contract expiration during the term of this bid. Awarded vendors will be advised. Location of pits and plants are as follows:
  - **Cold Laid** - Frontera Materials (La Joya Plant)
  - **Type D Hot Mix- Gravel** (Frontera Materials Progreso Plant)
  - **Type D Hot Mix - Limestone** (Frontera Materials Progreso Plant)
  - **Crushed Caliche** - Frontera Materials - (FM 490 Pit and/or Moorefield Pit) and Valley Caliche - Mann Pit.
2. Hidalgo County reserves the right to award the bid on a lump sum basis to one bidder or to multiple bidders if the County determines it is in its best interest to do so.
3. **Bid price for the services must be per ton basis, per mile radius on an “As Needed Basis”.**
4. Bid award will be based on the low bid per ton basis per mile radius listed on the bid page form.
5. Hidalgo County Precinct No. 1 is requesting the minimum of **Ten (10) vendors owned and/or leased hauling trucks** that will be available for this bid with a minimum of twenty-two (22) tons per load. **Please note the make, year, model and capacity of your hauling trucks on Exhibit “D”.**
6. The bidder(s) awarded the contract must furnish proof of possessing all necessary licenses, ownership (title for all owned vehicles) and permits and also provide evidence of the required insurance as outlined in Exhibit “C”. Copies of all licences, permits and insurance coverage must be submitted to the Hidalgo County Purchasing Department upon bid award.
7. The bidder(s) awarded the contract **cannot** engage the services of a **subcontractor without prior written consent of Hidalgo County** to perform services hereunder. The successful bidder(s) must

present evidence that the proposed subcontractor possess all the necessary licenses and permits to perform the services and that subcontractor has obtained the required insurance.

8. **Bidder(s) will be required to complete and submit the Supplemental Hauling Data Sheet for every driver as detailed in Exhibit "E" upon bid award.**
9. Contractual agreement is not exclusive, as Precinct #1 may use own hauling vehicles when necessary.
10. Any contract award to a successful bidder will be in effect until (a) the contract expires, (b) delivery and acceptance of products, and/or performance of services ordered, or (c) terminated by County with thirty (30) day's written notice prior to cancellation.

## **SECTION II - OTHER/ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- The locations for the awarded vendor(s) for hauling of road materials currently have contracts and will expire as stated for each vendor(s) and may, at the County's sole discretion, be extended for an additional sixty (60) days, unless this contract is terminated pursuant to the provisions herein, whichever occurs first. Therefore; bidder(s) should be aware that additional contractual period contract(s) may be awarded for road materials upon expiration of current contracts.
- Hidalgo County is requesting that any and all questions, inquiries, and clarifications regarding quotes, bids, proposals or statement of qualifications be addressed to Martha L. Salazar, CPPB/Purchasing Agent at 100 E. Cano, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Edinburg, Texas 78539. **TELEPHONE INQUIRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. ALL WRITTEN INQUIRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED VIA FACSIMILE NO LATER THAN, Wednesday, April 9, 2008, by 5:00 P.M. at (956) 318-2629. Responses to said inquires will be sent to all applicants via facsimile by no later than 5:00 P.M., Friday, April 11, 2008.**
- All costs and expenses associated with the preparation and submission of (bids, proposals and/or quotes) shall be the responsibility of the bidder and not reimbursements for such charges or expenses shall be passed onto Hidalgo County.
- **Term of Contract** shall be for the period of one (1) year with the County's option to extend for one (1) additional year on an "As Needed Basis".
- The County of Hidalgo Precinct # 1 reserves the right to continue this bid for an additional sixty (60) day Grace Period at the end of the contract term for unforeseen delay in award of new bid for next contract term.
