- All fields for the "Law Enforcement Executive/Program Official" and "Government Executive/Financial Official" are required. Failure to complete any field may cause a

delay in your agency receiving the grant application and also may lead to a delay in your agency receiving grant funds.

- The "Law Enforcement Executive/Program Official" and "Government Executive/Financial Official" must have the ultimate signatory authority to sign contracts on behalf of the entity identified as the "Legal Name" located in the "Organization Information" section of the BIF.
- Under the "Organization Information" section, if you do not know your ORI Number, please leave it blank. This field may be entered by the COPS Office during the review process.

As a reminder, it is highly recommended that you save your completed BIF before submitting it, and retain it as part of your local records for this award.
