

AMENDMENT TO EXHIBIT "A"

PERFORMANCE STATEMENT

The U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development has requested that the Hidalgo County-Urban County Program utilize Surplus Funds that were not recaptured from prior years. Agreements for the awarding of the Surplus Funds were presented and approved by Commissioners' Court on March 17, 2009.

THE SALVATION ARMY, having been certified as a non-profit, has been allocated Emergency Shelter Grant Surplus Funds (ESG). The non-profit shall carry out the following activities identified in its ESG Surplus Funds Program Application:

MAINTENANCE & OPERATIONS / ESSENTIAL SERVICES/HOMELESS PREVENTION ACTIVITIES

The Salvation Army shall utilize the ESG Surplus funds for maintenance and operations of their emergency shelter. The funds are used to maintain and operate the shelter; food, clothing, telephone, utilities, furniture, equipment, furnishings; essential services, and homeless prevention services. A total of \$206,453.41 was awarded to the Salvation Army as follows:

\$ 114,495.72 for maintenance and operations; \$32,764.35 in essential services; and \$59,193.34 for homeless prevention activities.

The agreement was approved beginning March 17, 2009 and ends June 30, 2009. The agreement was for 3 ½ months.

This request is to amend the ESG Surplus Funds agreement with The Salvation Army from June 30, 2009 through Sept. 30, 2009.
