Hidalgo County Judge's Office-Division of Emergency Services with Hidalgo County Health and Human Services and the City of McAllen are hosting the Dare to Prepare Disaster Readiness Expo on Saturday, July 11th, 2009 at the McAllen Convention Center. The goal of this expo is to demonstrate our level of preparedness as well as inform the public of the many things they can do to educate themselves. We have a variety of agencies—governmental and non-profit—as well as some vendors participating. We plan to have about 50 booths, as well as a panel of speakers, a rock wall, a motorcycle show hosted by SPI Bike Fest and more. It should be a very exciting day!!

What does this event cost?

From HCHHS Preparedness Grant: \$5,000 (this will pay for decorations, booth set up, registration table, food for volunteers, and our booths manager)

City of McAllen donated use of the Convention Center Exhibit Hall B including power, use of the marquee and they are providing their staff to help us with logistics as well. **Several thousand in donations, est. \$10,000**

We have received **\$4,000 in sponsorships** that will be used to pay for advertising with Time Warner Cable, Univision Radio, as well as ASL interpretation services, posters. Our sponsors, which are paying the vendors direct, are:
