**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
HIDALGO COUNTY HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA TASK FORCE
AND THE McALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIDTA TASK FORCE** and the **McALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICE DEPARTMENT** are located in close proximity and have law enforcement, crime prevention and close government ties; and

WHEREAS, the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIDTA TASK FORCE** and the **McALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICE DEPARTMENT** have heretofore entered into an agreement providing for the exchange of governmental services relating to the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIDTA TASK FORCE**; and

WHEREAS, the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIDTA TASK FORCE** has certain surplus equipment and the **McALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICE DEPARTMENT** has a need for such surplus equipment which can be utilized in providing the service of crime prevention and law enforcement in and for the **McALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICE DEPARTMENT** and in relationship to the **McALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICE DEPARTMENT** contribution to the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIDTA TASK FORCE**.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the following, the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIDTA TASK FORCE** and the **McALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICE DEPARTMENT** hereby agree as follows:

1. The **HIDALGO COUNTY HIDTA TASK FORCE** will permanently transfer to the **McALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICE DEPARTMENT** certain surplus equipment owned by the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIDTA TASK FORCE** which is designated as

• **ONE (1) 2002 FORD F-150 SUPER CREW 4x4 PICKUP
VIN#1FTRW08L32KA47681**

Such surplus equipment is being permanently transferred in "as-is" condition and the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIDTA TASK FORCE** makes no warranty in any manner as to the fitness of the equipment for any purpose.

2. Such equipment is to be delivered to the **McALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICE DEPARTMENT** and shall be solely used for "law enforcement purposes" by the **McALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICE DEPARTMENT** as set forth under **THE STATE OF TEXAS CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, CHAPTER 59.**
3. The **McALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICE DEPARTMENT** shall solely be responsible for all expenditures and requirements of said equipment as set forth under **THE STATE OF TEXAS CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, CHAPETER 59.**



DEFAULT JUDGMENT

ON this date, came to be considered the above-entitled and numbered cause wherein the State of Texas as Plaintiff alleged that it had seized **ONE (1) 2002 FORD F-150 PICKUP, VIN #1FTRW08L32KA47681**, alleged in the Original Notice of Seizure and Intended Forfeiture filed herein.

The Court finds that citation and certified copy of Plaintiff's Original Notice and Intention to Forfeit were duly and personally served on **JOSE ALEJANDRO RODRIGUEZ and ANGEL ALBERTO LOPEZ** by posting at the courthouse door pursuant to Article 59.04(c) Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, and that said citations were returned to the Clerk of the Court where they have remained on file for the time required by law. The Court finds that no answers have been filed herein by the above-named defendants and that the defendants have failed to appear and have wholly made default.

Plaintiff, THE STATE OF TEXAS, announced ready for trial and presented evidence to the Court that the **ONE (1) 2002 FORD F-150 PICKUP, VIN #1FTRW08L32KA47681**, the subject of this suit, was contraband pursuant to Article 59.01, Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, in that it was used or intended to be used in the commission of a felony under Chapter 481 of the Texas Health and Safety Code. Pursuant to Article 59.05(e), said **ONE (1) 2002 FORD F-150 PICKUP, VIN #1FTRW08L32KA47681** should be forfeited to the Criminal District Attorney of Hidalgo County, Texas as agent for the State of Texas, and the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA "HIDTA" TASK FORCE**, in accordance with their local agreement.

The Court, after duly considering the evidence and the law, is of the opinion and so finds that **ONE (1) 2002 FORD F-150 PICKUP, VIN #1FTRW08L32KA47681**, the subject of this suit, is contraband as defined in the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 59.01(2). The court further finds that the said **ONE (1) 2002 FORD F-150 PICKUP, VIN #1FTRW08L32KA47681** was used or intended to be used in violation of the Texas Controlled Substance Act, Chapter 481 of the Texas Health and Safety Code. Plaintiff, pursuant to Articles 59.01(2), 59.05(e) of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure requests that **ONE (1) 2002 FORD F-150 PICKUP, VIN #1FTRW08L32KA47681**, the subject of this suit, be forfeited to the CRIMINAL DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF HIDALGO COUNTY, as agent for the State of Texas and the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA "HIDTA" TASK FORCE**, in accordance with their local agreement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the **ONE (1) 2002 FORD F-150 PICKUP, VIN #1FTRW08L32KA47681**, made the subject of this suit and identified in Plaintiff's Criminal Petition and Notice of Seizure, is hereby disposed in the following manner:

ONE (1) 2002 FORD F-150 PICKUP, VIN #1FTRW08L32KA47681 is forfeited to the CRIMINAL DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS and the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA "HIDTA" TASK FORCE**, pursuant to the parties' local agreement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **ONE (1) 2002 FORD F-150 PICKUP, VIN #1FTRW08L32KA47681**; hereinafter referred to as the "subject vehicle"; the subject of this suit, be awarded to the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA "HIDTA" TASK FORCE** to be used for Law Enforcement purposes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the "subject vehicle" be released INSTANTER to the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA "HIDTA" TASK FORCE**, and the State Department of Highway and Public Transportation is ordered to issue valid certificate of title to **HIDALGO COUNTY HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA "HIDTA" TASK FORCE** for the "subject vehicle".


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event the "subject vehicle" is to be sold at auction by the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA "HIDTA" TASK FORCE** pursuant to the Texas Transportation Code and/or the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, the State Department of Highway and Public Transportation is ordered to issue valid certificate of title to the PURCHASER of the "subject vehicle" subsequent to the sale at auction.

All relief not expressly granted is hereby denied.

All costs of Court in this cause shall be adjudged against the **HIDALGO COUNTY HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA "HIDTA" TASK FORCE**.
