1. That Constable Lazaro "Larry" Gallardo Jr. is authorized to request grant funding under the Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council. Request for Applications of the Regional Solid Waste Grants Program and act on behalf of County of Hidalgo in all matters related to the grant application and any subsequent grant contract and grant project that may result.
2. That if the project is funded, County of Hidalgo will comply with the grant requirements of the Lower Rio Grande Development Council, Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the State of Texas.
3. The grant funds and any grant-funded equipment or facilities will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant.
4. That activities will comply with and support the adopted regional and local solid waste management plans adopted for the geographical area in which the activities are performed.
