RE: **Canuck Village Subdivision– Pct. 1**
Final Approval

Canuck Village is a fifty one (51) lot subdivision located on the Northwest intersection of Mile 2 West Road and Mile 12 North Road.

The proposed Subdivision lies within the City of Weslaco E.T.J. and was approved by the Planning and Zoning and City Commission of said City.

The Drainage Report was submitted to, reviewed, and approved by the H.C.D.D. No. 1 Manager on November 21, 2008. The proposed subdivision lies within a Zone "X & AE" as per FEMA's FIRM.

The proposed subdivision plat will dedicate twenty (20) feet on Mile 12 North Road and ten (10) feet on Mile 2 West Road of additional Road Right of Way in accordance with the Hidalgo County Thoroughfare Plan.

Sanitary Sewer Services will be provided by OSSF. Soil Analysis were conducted by Rene Barrera, P.E. and approved by the Hidalgo County Environmental Health Department. All septic tank systems have been installed, inspected and can be expected to function satisfactorily.

Water Services will be provided by North Alamo Water Supply Corporation. There is an existing eight (8) inch waterline on Mile 12 Road that will serve as the primary source of water for the proposed development.

The Subdivision received Preliminary Approval from the Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court on March 31, 2009. The Subdivision Plat has been reviewed and complies with the Hidalgo County Subdivision Rules, Texas Water Development Board Model Subdivision Rules and the Texas Local Government Code.

The Hidalgo County Advisory Board convened and recommended **Final Approval** on **September 28, 2009**.
