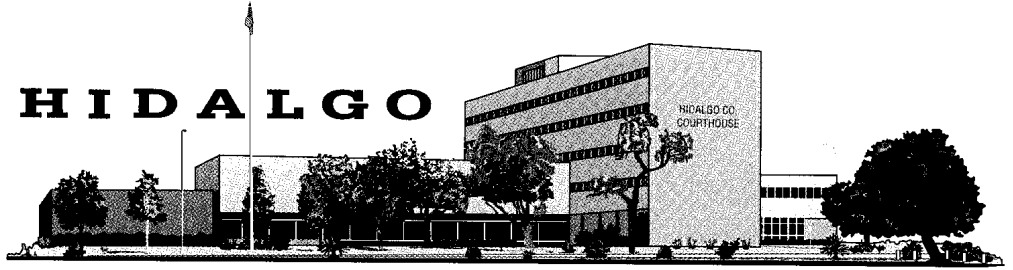


Pursuant to Local Government Code § 111.0706 SPECIAL BUDGET FOR GRANT OR AID MONEY:

The county auditor shall certify to the commissioners court the receipt of all public or private grant or aid money that is available for disbursement in a fiscal year but not included in the budget for that fiscal year. On certification, the court shall adopt a special budget for the limited purpose of spending the grant or aid money for its intended purpose.

I, Ray Eufrazio, County Auditor of Hidalgo County, certify to the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court the receipt of a grant award from the United States Marshal Service (USMS). These funds may now be made available by creating a new special budget or amending a current budget for its intended purposes.

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

SUBJECT: Vehicles for State and Local Task Force Participants

The Department of Justice awards funding gained from asset forfeitures to assist state and local law enforcement. I am pleased to announce that the United States Marshals Service (USMS) has been awarded \$15 million to acquire 600 vehicles for state and local law enforcement agencies who participate full-time on our Regional and District Fugitive Task Forces. The vehicles must be purchased before the end of fiscal year (FY) 2009 and they will become the sole property of the eligible state and local agencies.

In addition to the funding to purchase vehicles, we also received funding to outfit these vehicles with emergency equipment (\$5,000) and fuel (\$6,000). These separate funds will be transferred to district offices at the beginning of FY 2010. Districts will reimburse the state and local agencies to outfit and fuel their vehicles upon the presentation of valid invoices.

Specific guidance for acquiring the vehicles and handling all funds will be forthcoming. Also, the Investigative Operations Division intranet site will contain information to assist in this process.

The Investigative Operations Division is working closely with other USMS divisions and the Department of Justice to acquire additional asset forfeiture funding support for FY 2010.

Payment will be made directly to commercial vehicle dealerships for vehicles purchased for state and local investigators who participate in joint law enforcement task forces with the U.S. Marshals Service. Upon receipt of a proper invoice from the commercial vehicle dealership, the Marshals Service Office of Finance will issue payment directly to those dealerships. Copies of vehicle title must be provided to the U.S. Marshals Service to show that these vehicles are the property of the state and local agency and not the U.S. Marshals Service.
