**Approval of Meeting Minutes from February 02, 2010.**

**Cost Over-Run Projects**

TxDOT had none to report.

**MTP Update**

MPO staff requested the cities and agencies to provide information regarding the projects listed on the MTP list option 2 (off system projects only) not later than Wednesday March 10, 2010. Information should include which projects are priorities, what is the acquisition of ROW status and level of completion of the plans, specifications and estimates (PS&E) package for each project. Additionally, MTP staff requested TAC members to download the TREND software from the MPO website and run scenarios in order to address the \$400,000 shortfall in the MTP list. Sheets showing innovative financing options were distributed (attached). Further discussion followed and a motion to list only off system projects for Category 7 funds was carried unanimously. MPO staff provided an overview on how to use the TREND software.

**FY 2008-2011 TIP Amendment**

MPO staff provided a listing (attached) showing potential Economic Stimulus #2 candidates. The list assumes an allocation for Mobility projects similar to that for the first Stimulus. The list for Hidalgo County includes projects that would be ready to let in 90 days. Members were invited to submit additional potential projects. Staff notified that the TIP amendment will be further discussed in the next TAC meeting and taken to Policy in April.

**FY 2011-2014 TIP Update**

The item was briefly discussed and notified that this TIP update will be included for further discussion in the TAC agendas for April and May.

### **Thoroughfare Plan Update**

Members were reminded that agencies need to review the map and provide comments they may have.

### **Transit Passenger Questionnaire**

MPO staff provided a draft of the questionnaire and members were asked to comment on it.

### **Discussion of Operational Improvements Criteria**

There will be a subcommittee meeting on March 11 at 2:00 pm.

### **Status report Update**

#### **A – Calendar**

Calendar for March, April and May were provided and discussed over by MPO staff. Staff notified that registration for the Border to Border Conference in El Paso begins March 03, 2010.

#### **B – Legislative update**

MPO staff notified members that only 2 Texas projects were recipient of TIGER grant funding. MPO staff provided a memo showing a summary of the major provisions of the transportation section of the Senate Jobs Bill:

- The draft bill would extend SAFETEA-LU through December 31, 2010;
- The draft bill would provide funding at pre-rescission levels for the remainder of the calendar year and would restore funding back to the programs that was rescinded in September 2009;
- There is no language that would require projects to go to letting in 90 days;
- There are no ARRA style reporting requirements.

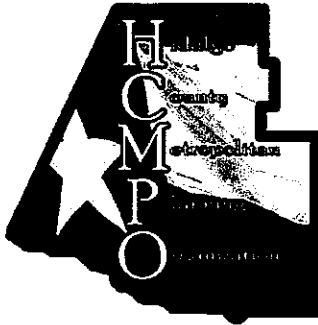
#### **C – HCMPO Budget Report**

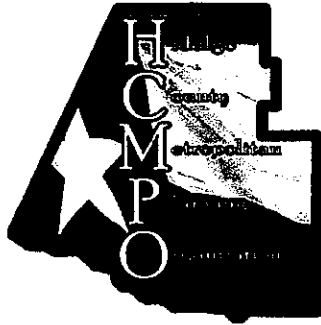

Dear TAC Members:

Attached is an agenda for the forthcoming TAC meeting scheduled on March 2, 2010 at the HCMPO office at 1:30pm.

On the agenda will be the need to address the MTP updates that need to be performed. At the previous Policy Committee meeting, staff and the TAC were given guidance to not fund any "on system" projects, but to only select "off system" projects. As we are proceeding with that guidance, HCMPO Staff and TAC Members have been asked to work with Trends in order to make up for the \$400M shortfall. Please visit our FTP site at [www.hcmppo.org/webfiles](http://www.hcmppo.org/webfiles) and download Trends. We ask that you try different scenarios and bring to the TAC meeting the best scenarios that would make up the shortfall. Attached you will also find innovative finance ideas that the HCMPO staff has been looking into that could also be considered as an option to address the financial needs locally.

At last month's TAC meeting, we handed out a spreadsheet of Option #2, and asked for you all to bring to the March TAC meeting the information needed for all the projects on the spreadsheet that pertain to your jurisdiction. Please don't forget to bring that information with you to the next TAC meeting. For those of you that were not present at February's TAC meeting, we emailed the spreadsheet to you so you can provide us with the information.

We need to begin to prepare for the second stimulus package, Jobs for Main Street Act. HCMPO Staff has been given the guidance to prepare like if we are to receive the same amount as for the first stimulus package, which was \$16.9. There are two projects that are ready to go:

- Westgate – CSJ#0921-02-184 (\$1,816,796)
- S. McColl Rd – CSJ#0921-02-171 (\$5,836,500)


The HCMPO needs to be prepared and program a project(s) for the amount of \$9.2. The project(s) need to be ready to go. Attached in this packet you will find the FY 2008-2011 TIP so you are aware of the projects that are already in the TIP, and there is also a spreadsheet listing potential projects. If the project or projects that get selected to fund with the second stimulus package are not in the FY 2008-2011 TIP, the TIP will need to be amended and public involvement will begin in March 2010 in order to take the recommendation for adoption by the Transportation Policy Committee (TPC) in April 2010.

HCMPO Staff has also been advised to begin the process for the FY 2011-2014 TIP Update. The FY 2011-2014 TIP needs to be submitted by June 2010. Public involvement will begin in March 2010, and recommendation will be presented to TPC for adoption in May 2010.

In addition to the information needed listed previously, we also need your final comments to the Thoroughfare Plan Update. At the last subcommittee meeting, members were asked to bring their final comments to the March TAC meeting. Once all information has been compiled and implemented, all cities will be asked to please provide a resolution of support of the Thoroughfare Plan Update from City Commissions.

There will be a brief update of the Operational Improvements Subcommittee along with a legislative update. Should you have any questions or comments, please do not hesitate in contacting us at the HCMPO at any time. *We look forward to seeing at the next meeting!*

February 02, 2010

1) Roll Call

- Secretary Michelle Leftwich called the meeting to order at 1:37pm. The Technical Advisory Committee Meeting was held at the Hidalgo County MPO Office at 510 South Pleasantview Drive, Weslaco, Texas. Present were representatives from the Cities of: Alamo, Donna, Edcouch, Hidalgo County, La Joya, McAllen, Mercedes, Mission, Penitas, Pharr, TxDOT, Weslaco, LRGVDC Transit and Hidalgo County RMA. Ex-Offio Members present: Hidalgo County Auditor's Office, McAllen Transit and Hidalgo County Judge's office.

2) Adoption of Minutes from: January 05, 2010

- Secretary Michelle Leftwich asked if there were any corrections to the minutes. No corrections were needed to the minutes of: January 05, 2010. *The City of La Joya made a motion to approve January 05, 2010 minutes listed as presented. The City of Alamo seconded the motion and upon a vote, the motion carried unanimously.*

3) Cost Over-Run Projects

4) Kimley-Horn Update on Project

#### 6) MTP Update
