

AMENDMENT TO EXHIBIT "A"

PERFORMANCE STATEMENT

MUJERES UNIDAS/WOMEN TOGETHER, having been certified as a non-profit, has been allocated 2008 Emergency Shelter Grant funds (ESG). The non-profit shall carry out the following activities identified in its 2008 ESG Program Application:

MAINTENANCE & OPERATIONS/ESSENTIAL SERVICES

Mujeres Unidas/Women Together shall utilize the 2008 ESG funds for maintenance and operations of their four (4) centers; Emergency Shelter, Transitional Housing, Family Justice Center, and the McAllen Outreach Center. Their emergency shelter houses victims of domestic abuse and their children. The funds are used to maintain and operate the shelter; food, clothing, telephone, utilities, furniture, minor repairs, etc. They also receive funds under essential services to pay for the salaries of case workers/counselors to administer the program and provide client referrals. A total of \$186,564.00 were awarded to Mujeres Unidas/Women Together as follows: \$155,133.00 for maintenance and operations and \$31,431.00 for essential services.

The contract for Mujeres Unidas/Women Together was approved beginning July 1, 2008 and ended April 30, 2010.

This amendment is to extend the contract deadline for Mujeres Unidas/Women Together from April 30, 2010 to June 15, 2010 for the expenditure of ESG funds for YR 21.
