Dear Mr. Zavala:

We have received the application for the above referenced permit and it is currently under review. Your attention to the following items is requested before we can declare the application administratively complete. Please submit one original and two copies (including a cover letter) of the complete response.

1. Application Fee: You submitted a payment of \$315.00 for the application processing fee. However, because the County of Hidalgo's permitted flow amount is for a volume not to exceed a daily average flow of 5,000 gallons per day from the wastewater treatment facility, the application fee is \$515.00. Please submit an additional \$200.00 payment to TCEQ, Revenue Section (MC 214), P.O. Box 13088, Austin, Texas 78711-3088. Also, please provide a copy of this check with your response to this letter.
2. Item 3.d. on page 4 of the administrative report: You did not list the street address of the Delta Lake Park Office. Please list the street address. If the Delta Lake Park Office does not have a street address, then please provide a location description of the office, using the direction and distance from road intersections.
3. Item 5.g. on page 7 of the administrative report: You submitted a Google map. TCEQ requires the submission of a full-sized, colored, topographic map that is printed by the U.S. Geological Survey or one that is an exact replica of the topographic map that is printed by the U.S. Geological Survey. Please provide a colored, full-sized USGS topographic map (7.5 minute, 1:24,000 scale) showing: the outline of the applicant's approximate property boundaries; the location of the

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permitted facility within the applicant's property boundaries; the labeled point of discharge; the discharge route manually highlighted with a light color, enabling the underlying topographic characteristics to be seen; and a radius of at least one mile in all directions of the facility.

Additionally, the following is required of the USGS topographic map:

- Map must be colored;
 - Map must contain clear contour lines;
 - Upper left corner must identify map as USGS Department of the Interior Geological Survey;
 - Lower left corner must have datum & project information such as mapped, edited, and published by the Geological Survey Control by USGS and NOS/NOAA, etc.;
 - Bottom, 1/3 of the way across page, map must show the magnetic declination;
 - Bottom center of map must show scale;
 - Bottom center of map (below scale) must identify contour intervals;
 - Bottom center of map (below contour intervals) must have national map accuracy standard statement;
 - Bottom, 2/3 of the way across page, map must show State of Texas and quadrangle location;
 - Map must show latitude and longitude coordinates around the perimeter;
 - Bottom right corner must identify quadrangle name;
 - Bottom right corner (below quadrangle name) must identify map date.
4. Item 5.h. on page 7 of the administrative report: This item was not completed. Please provide the latitude and longitude of the outfall.
 5. Item 5.j. on page 7 of the administrative report: This item was not completed. Please confirm that facility is publicly-owned.
 6. Item 6 on page 3 of the technical report: You listed this section as not applicable. Please clarify how sludge is handled at your facility.
 7. Item 14 on page 7 of the technical report: The laboratory accreditation statement was not signed. Please sign the certification statement and return the page to us with your response to this letter.
 8. The following is a portion of the Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain a Water Quality Permit. Please read it carefully and indicate if it contains any errors or omissions.

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

County of Hidalgo, c/o Hidalgo County Precinct 1, 1902 Joe Stephens Avenue, Weslaco, Texas 78596, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to renew Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0010973001 (EPA I.D. No. TX0072133) to authorize the discharge of treated wastewater at a volume not to exceed a daily average flow of 5,000 gallons per day. The domestic wastewater treatment facility is located approximately 2 miles north of the intersection of Farm-to-Market Roads 88 and 1422, east of Farm-to-Market Road 88, adjacent to the Monte Alto Reservoir in Hidalgo County, Texas 78538. The discharge route is from the plant site to Hidalgo and Willacy Water Control and Improvement District Ditch No. 1; thence to the Laguna Madre. TCEQ received this application on June 29, 2010. The permit application is available for viewing and copying at The Delta Lake Park Office, [*Farm-to-Market Road 88?? further location description?*], 2 miles north of Monte Alto, Edcouch, Texas.
