**PROGRAM AMENDMENT**

In compliance with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) requirements, the City of Alamo will conduct a Public Hearing to solicit input from interested parties on the City's proposed Program Amendment to its Urban County program, Year 20 & 22 ( 2007 & 2009 ) .

The Public Hearing will be held on August 3, 2010 at 7:00PM at the Alamo City Hall located at 420 North Tower Road.

Following is the proposed Program Amendment for your consideration:

The proposed amendment to the Street Improvements line item will **include** a new project: the installation of solar street lights along Duranta Avenue (from Tower Road to Alamo Road and along Main Street Park between 9<sup>th</sup> Street and 7<sup>th</sup> Place). There are surplus funds in the amount of **\$2,120.00**. The proposed program amendment will not affect the original Year 20- 2007budget, all projects were completed.

The proposed amendment to the Street Improvements line item will **delete** the Ridge Road project and will **include** the installation of solar street lights along Duranta Avenue from Tower Road to Alamo Road and along Main Street Park between 9<sup>th</sup> Street and 7<sup>th</sup> Place. The proposed program amendment will not affect the original Year 22- 2009 budget, only the project being proposed. Notice is given that a balance of **\$98,929.65** is available for the proposed project.

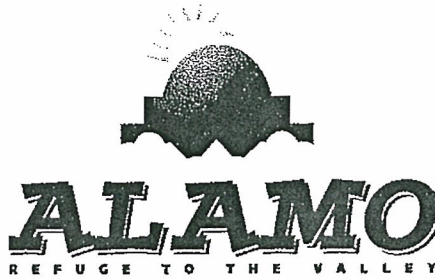
