Preliminary Approval

Urbina Subdivision is a two (2) lot subdivision located along the West side of Kenyon Road approximately ¼ mile South of Mile 19 North Road.

The proposed Subdivision lies within the City of Edinburg E.T.J. and was approved by the Planning and Zoning and City Commission of said City.

The Drainage Report was submitted to, reviewed, and approved by the H.C.D.D. No. 1 Manager on June 3, 2010. The proposed subdivision lies within a Zone "A" as per FEMA's FIRM.

The proposed subdivision plat will dedicate ten (10) feet on Kenyon Road of additional Road Right of Way in accordance with the Hidalgo County Thoroughfare Plan.

Sanitary Services will be provided by OSSF. Soil Analysis were conducted by Jose Angel Gonzalez and approved by the Environmental Health Department.

Water Services will be provided by North Alamo Water Supply Corporation. There is an existing four (4) inch waterline on Kenyon Road that will serve as the primary source of water for the proposed development.

The Subdivision Plat has been reviewed and complies with the Hidalgo County Subdivision Rules, Texas Water Development Board Model Subdivision Rules and the Texas Local Government Code. Staff comments are attached for your review.

The Hidalgo County Advisory Board convened and recommended **Preliminary Approval** on **August 17, 2010** subject to staff comments, future recommendations by Planning and other departments and the approval from the City of Edinburg.
