Final Approval

Valeria Estates is a two (2) lot subdivision located along the West side of La Homa Road approximately ½ mile South of Mile 7 North Road.

The proposed Subdivision lies within the City of Mission E.T.J. and was approved by the Planning and Zoning and City Commission of said City.

The Drainage Report was submitted to, reviewed, and approved by the H.C.D.D. No. 1 Manager on March 12, 2010. The proposed subdivision lies within a Zone “X” as per FEMA’s FIRM.

The proposed subdivision plat will dedicate twenty (20) feet on La Homa Road of additional Road Right of Way in accordance with the Hidalgo County Thoroughfare Plan.

Sanitary Services will be provided by OSSF. Soil Analysis were conducted by Aniceto Izaguirre and approved by the Environmental Health Department. All septic tank systems have been installed, inspected and can be expected to function satisfactorily.

Water Services will be provided by Sharyland Water Supply Corporation. There is an existing six (6) inch waterline on La Homa Road that will serve as the primary source of water for the proposed development.

The Subdivision Plat received Preliminary Approval from the Hidalgo County Commissioner’s Court on April 27, 2010. The Subdivision Plat has been reviewed and complies with the Hidalgo County Subdivision Rules, Texas Water Development Board Model Subdivision Rules and the Texas Local Government Code.

The Hidalgo County Advisory Board convened and recommended **Final Approval** on **August 17, 2010**.
