

Right of Entry Agreement between
The United States Government
and

Hidalgo County.

This shall serve as a temporary agreement between: Hidalgo County, hereinafter referred to as Grantor, whose mailing address is 100 E Cano Edinburg TX and the Federal Emergency Management Agency, hereinafter referred to as Grantee, whose mailing address is 800 N Loop 288 Denton TX. The parties are collectively referred to as the Parties to this Agreement.

Whereas, the Parties mutually agree to a "Right of Entry" providing Grantee access to space located at 100 E Cano Edinburg TX for the purpose of positioning and operating a FEMA / SBA MDRC/DRC site. The MDRC/DRC will serve the victims of Hurricane Alex (1931).

The Parties further agree to the following general terms and conditions:

- The Grantee shall have access to the premises 24 hours a day.
- The Grantee shall be permitted to employ armed guards on the premises.
- The Grantee agrees not to place its vehicles or trailers in areas that will interfere with the ingress and egress to the site.
- The Grantee will provide a written notice within 24 hours of vacating the premises.
- The signing of this form will act as a binding agreement between the above mentioned parties until a formal lease agreement is signed.
