RE: **Loma Verde Subdivision – Pct. 4**
Final Approval

Loma Verde Subdivision is a nineteen (19) lot subdivision located on the Southwest corner of Jesus Flores Road and Valdez Road.

The proposed Subdivision lies within the Rural Area of the County.

The Drainage Report was submitted to, reviewed, and approved by the H.C.D.D. No. 1 Manager on May 19, 2010. The proposed subdivision lies within a Zone "X" as per FEMA's FIRM.

The proposed subdivision plat was submitted to, reviewed, and approved by J. Benito Rodriguez, ROW Agent on June 8, 2010. The proposed subdivision plat will dedicate ten (10) feet on Mile 22 ½ (Valdez Rd) and twenty (20) feet on Filegonia Road of additional Road Right of Way in accordance with the Hidalgo County Thoroughfare Plan.

Sanitary Services will be provided by OSSF. Soil Analysis were conducted by Jose Angel Gonzalez and approved by the Hidalgo County Environmental Health Department. All septic tank systems have been installed, inspected and can be expected to function satisfactorily.

Water Services will be provided by North Alamo Water Supply Corporation. There is an existing eight (8) inch waterline on Mile 22 ½ North Road that will serve as the primary source of water for the proposed development.

The Subdivision received Preliminary Approval from the Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court on June 22, 2010. The Subdivision Plat has been reviewed and complies with the Hidalgo County Subdivision Rules, Texas Water Development Board Model Subdivision Rules and the Texas Local Government Code.

The Hidalgo County Advisory Board convened and recommended **Final Approval on December 7, 2010.**
