AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

THIS AGREEMENT is made, by and between HIDALGO COUNTY, acting herein by and through the Commissioner's Court, hereinafter called the "Owner", and S&B INFRASTRUCTURE, LTD., professional engineers of McAllen, Texas, hereinafter called the "Engineer".

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the Owner desires to contract with the Engineer to provide professional engineering services for the *advance project development (APD), preliminary engineering, final design, and plans, specifications & estimates (PSS&E) for the Inner-Outer Loop within Precinct 4, Hidalgo County, Texas* (hereinafter referred to as the "Project").

NOW, THEREFORE, the Owner and the Engineer in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained do mutually agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Employment of Engineer. The Owner agrees to employ the Engineer and the Engineer agrees to perform professional engineering services in connection with the Project as stated in the articles to follow, and for having rendered such services, the Owner agrees to pay the Engineer compensation as stated in the articles to follow.

ARTICLE 2. Character and Extent of Services. This Agreement will provide for the development of the Project with the following:

2.1. Scope of Work. The Owner will furnish items and provide those services for the development of the Project and fulfillment of this Agreement, as identified in EXHIBIT "A" -*Services to be Provided by the Owner*, attached hereto and made a part of this Agreement. The Engineer shall render professional services for the development of the Project and fulfillment of this Agreement as follows (and more particularly identified in EXHIBIT "B" -*Services to be Provided by the Engineer*, attached hereto and made a part of this
