

**AMENDMENT TO EXHIBIT "A"  
PERFORMANCE STATEMENT**

The Mujeres Unidas/Women Together having been certified as a non-profit, has been allocated ESG Funds. The non-profit shall carry out the following activities identified in its ESG Funds Application:

**MAINTENANCE & OPERATIONS/ ESSENTIAL SERVICES / HOMELESS PREVENTION SERVICES**

Mujeres Unidas/Women Together shall utilize ESG Funds for maintenance and operations, essential services and homeless prevention activities. Maintenance and operations funds are used for the operation of the shelter and essential services are to be used for salaries of counseling staff. A total of \$116,309.00 was awarded; \$76,078.00 for maintenance and operations and \$40,231.00 for essential services.

The subrecipient agreement entered between Mujeres Unidas/Women Together and the Hidalgo County –Urban County Program was approved on July 1, 2009 and will end on December 31, 2010.

Mujeres Unidas/Women Together has requested of the Urban County Program that their agreement be extended until March 31, 2011 to be able to expend all the funds awarded. The total grant amount awarded to Mujeres Unidas/Women Together in the amount of \$ 116,309.00 will not change.

This Agreement, made and entered into on this the 1st day of July, 2009 by and between **Hidalgo County-Urban County Program**, hereinafter referred to as "ENTITY," a political subdivision of the State of Texas and **Mujeres Unidas/Women Together**, a neighborhood based not-for-profit organization, hereinafter referred to as "SUBRECIPIENT".

**WITNESSETH**

WHEREAS, the **SUBRECIPIENT** desires to carry out eligible activities as described in **Exhibit A** and permitted by 24 CFR §576.21 ; and

WHEREAS, the **ENTITY** proposes to contract with **SUBRECIPIENT** in order that the special activities described in **Exhibit A** can be carried out in the **ENTITY's** jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the **ENTITY** has made a finding that those activities listed in **Exhibit A** are eligible under 24 CFR 576.21;

**NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:** That for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein set forth and other good and valuable consideration, the **ENTITY** and the **SUBRECIPIENT** do mutually agree as follows:

**SECTION I  
Rules and Regulations**

The **SUBRECIPIENT** agrees to cooperate with the **ENTITY** in respect to the implementation of Emergency Shelter Grant Program activities to be carried out by **SUBRECIPIENT** pursuant to 24 CFR Part 576 and other rules, regulations and decisions as may be made by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) or any other federal or state **ENTITY** that may legally exercise its jurisdiction over expenditures of ESG funds.

**SECTION II  
Statement of Work**

**SUBRECIPIENT** agrees to perform services as outlined in **Exhibit A: Statement of Work**, of this Agreement for and in consideration of ESG funding in the amount of \$116,309.00 enumerated in

Effective Date

The effective date of this contract shall be the 1st day of July, 2009, such date being the date the County Commissioners' Court approved entering into this Agreement with SUBRECIPIENT, and shall terminate on the 31st day of Dec., 2010. \*Non-profits funding will be for a period of one and one half (1 1/2) years and a two (2) year period for the grantee (UCP). ). An extension can be granted by the UCP director up to a period of 2 years.

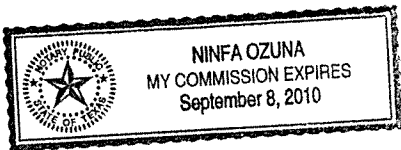
