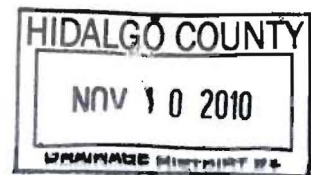

Mainstream Funding Invitation**

Dear Mr. Garza:

This letter serves as official notice that the Hidalgo County Drainage District # 1 (District) is eligible to apply for a CWSRF loan utilizing the Mainstream funding option to fund project # 8819 as listed on the SFY 2011 CWSRF Intended Use Plan's (IUP's) Project Priority List. Please consider this letter as the District's invitation to submit an application for SFY 2011 CWSRF Mainstream funding to the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB).

Although project # 8819 is eligible for Disadvantaged Community funding, there are currently no such funds available. Disadvantaged Community funds may become available if other invitees on the Fundable Projects List decline their invitations or do not meet the required deadlines. If this occurs, any available Disadvantaged Community funds will be offered to eligible applicants in priority order.

SFY 2011 Mainstream funding is available at an interest rate of 1.30% below market rates and a term of 30 years. The District has 30 days from the date of this letter to notify the TWDB in writing if it will accept or decline this invitation. Therefore, the District's **invitation response deadline is December 6, 2010**. An invitation response form is enclosed for this purpose. If the TWDB does not receive the District's acceptance of this invitation by the deadline, the funds allocated to the District's project will be offered to eligible applicants in priority order.

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If the District either previously indicated or, upon further review, has determined that project # 8819 contains one or more green components, the District will need to fill out and return the Green Project Information Worksheets to verify Green Project Reserve eligibility. The green worksheets are accessible online at <www.twdb.state.tx.us/assistance/financial/resources/documents/twdb-0162.docm>. The District has 30 days from the date of this letter to submit the green worksheets. Therefore, the District's **green worksheet submission deadline is December 6, 2010.**

If the District accepts the invitation and has submitted an invitation response, the next step is to schedule a pre-application conference. The TWDB recommends that the pre-application conference be scheduled as soon as possible due to the timeframe required for submittal of an application. Please note that the District will have three (3) months from the date of this letter to submit an application to the TWDB. Therefore, the District's **application deadline is February 7, 2011.** The District's project will be bypassed if a completed application is not submitted in a timely manner. Projects that do not receive SFY 2011 funding may be submitted during the solicitation period for consideration to be included in a future fiscal year IUP.

The TWDB looks forward to working with the Hidalgo County Drainage District # 1 on its wastewater improvement project. 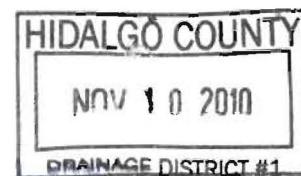
