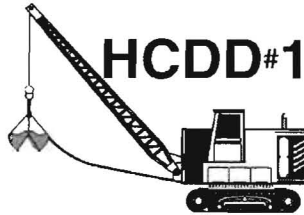



Notice: This report represents observations made by the attendees of the items discussed below. The observations reported herein were conducted on the date and during the period listed above. Unless notified to the contrary within seven (7) days from the date of issue, the contents of this report are assumed to be accurate and will stand for the record as written.

Items Discussed:

1. Erosion damage along edge of concrete riprap on east end of project on river side of wall. Contractor has completed re-grading and reseeding of the area and has install erosion protection mat adjacent to eastern edge of concrete riprap as noted on the previous punch list. Engineer and Environmental Monitor will continue to monitor until required vegetation is achieved.

Other Items Noted By Attendees (Not Considered by the Engineer to be Punch Items or responsibility of the DHS Segment O-08 Contractor):

1. Remove Port-A-John on landside about one-quarter mile east of the west end of the Project. Port-A-John does not belong to Project Contractor.
2. Remove vegetation on riverside adjacent to wall. Project has been completed for over a year and Contractor has already removed all vegetation twice. It is the Engineer's opinion that the project has been used for its use for over a year now; therefore, it is not reasonable to continue requiring the Contractor to remove this vegetation. It is now the responsibility of the USIBWC.
3. Two (2) deep ruts in riverside leg of American Farms access ramp. It is the Engineer's opinion that the project has been used for its use for over a year now; therefore, it is not reasonable to continue requiring the Contractor to maintain the caliche roads. Moreover, this damage resulted from farmer hauling operations.
4. Overflow from irrigation ditch midway between Bell & American Farms access ramps. Farmer plowing operations have resulted in siltation over drainage pipes in access ramps causing excess irrigation from flowing to drainage outfall; therefore, results in the ditch adjacent to the perimeter flowing on to the perimeter. It is the Engineer's opinion that this is not a Contractor issue and should be dealt with by the
