Engineer for project was Javier Hinojosa and the construction firm was Mission Paving. Project was completed within two weeks from letting.


The following streets were completed utilizing other fund source.

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



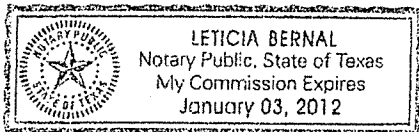
