The purpose of this letter is to formally request a USIBWC Permit for the Delta Area Outfall Drainage Improvements Project. Hidalgo County – Texas Department of Rural Affairs Disaster Recovery Division has reviewed the entire requirement and determined that it has completed all requirements set forward by the United States International Boundary & Water Commission.

This project consist of construction for a 10'x10' box culverts, gateway structure with sluice gate through the USIBWC North Floodway levee, and an auxiliary pumping system which includes all its apparatus. The bridge will remain in place by adding concrete rip rap and headwall to protect the structure and improve conveyance.
