Nothing herein contained shall be held to vary, alter, waive or extend any of the terms, limits or conditions of the Public Official Bond, except as hereinabove set forth.

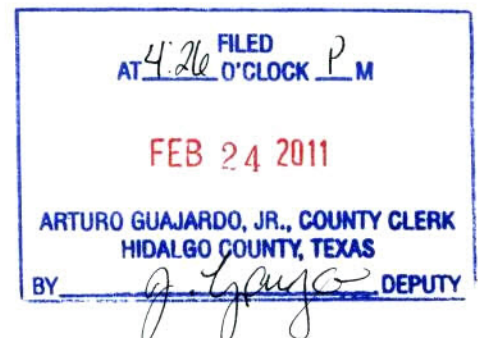
