**AMENDMENT No. 2 to SERVICE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS AND
EVERCOM SYSTEMS, INC, a division of SECURUS TECHNOLOGIES**

This **AMENDMENT No. 2** to the **HIDALGO COUNTY INMATE PAY TELEPHONE SERVICE AGREEMENT (C-05-191-12-06)** by and between **HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS** (“County”) and **EVERCOM SYSTEMS, INC, a division of SECURUS TECHNOLOGIES** (“Vendor”) is entered into between the parties effective this **3RD** day of **May, 2011**.

WHEREAS, Company and County entered into a Service Agreement effective December 06, 2005 in which Vendor agreed to provide certain services for “Inmate Pay Telephone Services” (the “Agreement”) at Hidalgo County Sheriff’s Department;

WHEREAS, the Agreement, as drafted, was not specific pertaining to the term;

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement as hereinafter provided;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the terms and provisions set forth herein, for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, County and Company hereby agree to the following amendment to further modify and change the grace period extension from One Hundred Fifty (150) Days to reflect an additional Forty Five (45) Days or upon award of the project whichever comes first:

1. **TERM:** Article 7. of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following substituted in lieu thereof:

The Contract consists of:

- A. This Agreement;
- B. Amendment No. 1 to Service Agreement, and;
- C. The original Service Agreement and Exhibit A and B, attached hereto and incorporated by reference for all purposes, hereinafter cumulatively referred to as the “Requirements” and “Contractor’s Response”.

2. Except as modified herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement, as amended, remain in full force and effect and Vendor and County ratify and confirm the terms and provisions of the Agreement, as amended.
